<u>ORDER</u>

The Superintendent's Designee denied Appellant's request to transfer his son to Seneca Valley High School for reasons related to participation the Naval Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps (NJROTC) program there. On appeal, the local board was unable to attain a majority of five votes to affirm or reverse, thus the decision of the Superintendent's Designee remained in effect. Thereafter, Appellant appealed the decision to the State Board.

The local board has requested that this matter be remanded to it for further review because new information came to light during the briefing stage of the State Board appeal that could impact the transfer decision.

Therefore, it is this 24th day of July, 2012 by the Maryland State Board of Education,

ORDERED, that the appeal referenced above is remanded to the local board for it to review whether or not Appellant's request for his son's transfer to Seneca Valley should be granted based on the new information.
