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Calibration and Equating Summary

Overview

This appendix provides a brief summary of the operational calibration and equating of the 2005 MSA mathematics tests. These tests were calibrated and equated using the same statistical methods and procedures that were employed in 2004. However, the use of a pre-selected calibration sample this year necessitated some additional analyses to verify the adequacy of the obtained sample.

As discussed later in this appendix, the 2005 tests performed as expected and the equated forms at each grade level produced very similar scale score distributions, reflecting the effective spiraling of test forms. Although the common-item calibration and equating design does not require equivalent groups, the consistency of the scale score means and the similarity of the test characteristic curves does provide additional reassurance about the quality of the calibration and equating. The 2005 results were compared with the results from 2004, and were found to be consistent in terms of item parameters, scale score distributions, score trends.

The procedures used to calibrate and equate the 2005 MSA mathematics tests, and the results of those procedures, are summarized below.

Verifying the Adequacy of the Calibration Sample.

The case counts for schools in the 2005 calibration sample were compared with the case counts for these schools in the 2004 GRT. These comparisons indicated that the representation of the selected schools in our calibration sample was consistent with our expectations. The 2004 and 2005 case counts are provided in Table 1.

The 2005 calibration sample distribution by race and gender was compared with the total 2004 MSA population by race and gender. The results are shown in Tables 2 and 3.

Both of these comparisons indicated that we had achieved the desired calibration sample. The case counts were extremely close to the 2004 counts from these schools, and the proportional representation of ethnic groups and of males and females at each grade were all within 3 percent of the target values¹.

The distribution of the 2005 examinee population by race and gender is provided in Tables 3 and 4 in of the 2005 Technical Report. A comparison of the sample demographics with those of the 2005 MSA examinee population confirms the representativeness of the calibration sample.

¹ The target value for each group was the exact proportional representation of that group tested in the calibration schools in 2004.

Verifying the Accuracy of Items and Scoring Keys.

Frequency distributions were examined to verify that items were producing the expected score distributions. Classical item analysis results also were examined and any marginal item statistics were compared with previous years' statistics for the same items.

The item analysis results were consistent with previous years' statistics, and no items were flagged as potential miskeys. The frequency distributions indicated that the constructed response items were yielding the full range of possible scores. The item analysis results are provided in Tables 4a to 9b. Raw score reliability coefficients ranged from .92 to .96.

Checking the Stability of Common Items on Alternate Forms

The stability of common items of common items on Form 1 and Form 2 was verified at each grade level, using the method proposed by Kolen and Brennan (1995):

- (1) Calibrate the two operational test forms separately.
- (2) Compare the a parameters (using log of a) and the b parameters for Form 1 and Form 2, and compare the parameter plots for Form 1 vs. Form 2.

After examining the item parameters and plots from the two separate calibrations, it was determined that the common item parameters were consistent across the two operational forms at each grade level, and that all of these items could be included as across-form anchors in the concurrent calibration of the two forms. The plots and item parameters from the separate calibrations are provided in Figures 1 to 6 and Tables 10 to 15.

Calibrating and Equating the Two Operational Test Forms at Each Grade Level.

At each grade level the two operational forms were calibrated together, using CTB's Pardux software to implement the same mixed model that was used in previous years (3PL for selected response items, and 2PPC for multiple choice items). All items converged within the specified number of iterations (i.e. < 100).

Each test form contained a representative set of anchor items from previous years' administrations, and these items were used to equate the item parameters and place the 2005 tests on the previous years' scale, using the Stocking and Lord test characteristic curve method.² The stability of the equating anchor items was evaluated using plots of the anchor item parameters, correlations, and root mean square errors.

The equating results showed high correlations for the a and b parameters, with no obvious outliers. As shown in Table 16, correlations of the estimated and anchor parameters ranged from .92 to .95 for the a parameters, and from .96 to .99 for the b parameters. The equating plots and test characteristic curves are shown in Figures 7 to 30.

² Note, however, that the HOSS and LOSS values for grades 3, 5, and 8 were changed this year, making them consistent with the values set last year for grades 4, 6, and 7. Beginning in 2005, the LOSS is at 240 and the HOSS at 650 for every grade.

Checking the Equating Results for Reasonableness.

The following checks were used for this to verify the reasonableness of the equating results:

- (1) The means and standard deviations of calibration sample students were compared for Form 1 vs. Form 2. If the spiraling of test forms was successful and the equating accurate, then the score distributions should be very similar for the two test forms.
- (2) The test characteristic curves for Form 1 and Form 2 were compared.
- (3) The 2005 scale scores and proficiency levels for the calibration sample were compared with the 2004 scale scores and proficiency levels for the schools in the calibration sample.

Figures 31 to 36 show the test characteristic curves and standard errors for Form 1 and Form 2 at each grade level. With the exception of Grade 7, the two test characteristic curves are virtually indistinguishable from one another. For Grade 7, however, Form 1 was somewhat more difficult than Form 2. An examination of the item analysis results (see Tables 8a and 8b) reveals the fact that while the selected response and constructed response items are similar in difficulty across the two forms, the gridded response items are not. The mean p-value for the 12 gridded-response items on Form 1 is only .367, while the mean p-value for the 12 gridded response items on Form 2 is .535. These values are consistent with the relative difficulty of the items when they were field tested in 2004. The statistics for the Grade 7 gridded response items are summarized in Table 17.

As shown in Table 18, the scale scores for Form 1 and Form 2 were within one point of each other at Grades 3, 5, 7, and 8. Form differences were somewhat greater at Grade 4 and Grade 6 (2.28 and 1.76 points, respectively). To check whether or not these form differences might be an artifact of the combined calibration, the scale scores for these two grades were compared with the results of the separate (by form) calibrations. When these tests were rescored using the parameters from the separate calibrations, the form differences were similar to those obtained using the results of the combined calibration: 2.49 points for Grade 4 and 1.44 points for Grade 6.

Table 19 summarizes the annual changes in mean test scores for the schools in the 2005 calibration sample. It is noteworthy that the 2005 mean test scores were approximately 8 to 13 points higher than the 2004 means, with the largest increases occurring in Grades 4, 6, and 7. While these increases seem quite large, they appear to be consistent with the increases observed between 2003 and 2004 in Grades 3, 5, and 8. The calibration sample scale score distributions for 2005 appear to be relatively normal, and very similar to the 2004 distributions. These scale score distributions are shown in Figures 37 to 42. These distributions are also very similar to the 2005 population distributions, which can be found in Appendix G of the 2005 Technical Report.

Finally, the proportions of students achieving proficient or better performance in 2004 and 2005 were compared for schools in the calibration sample. These comparisons are shown in Figure 43. As would be expected from the year-to-year increase in mean scores, the proportion of students achieving proficient or better performance at each grade level in 2005 is higher than the proportion in 2004. The general trend across grades in 2005 is similar to 2004, with the

proportion of students at or above proficient performance generally decreasing from Grade 4 to Grade 6 and from Grade 7 to Grade 8, with relatively little change from Grade 6 to Grade 7.

Figure 1. 2005 Grade 3 Common Item Parameter Comparison, Form 1 vs. Form 2

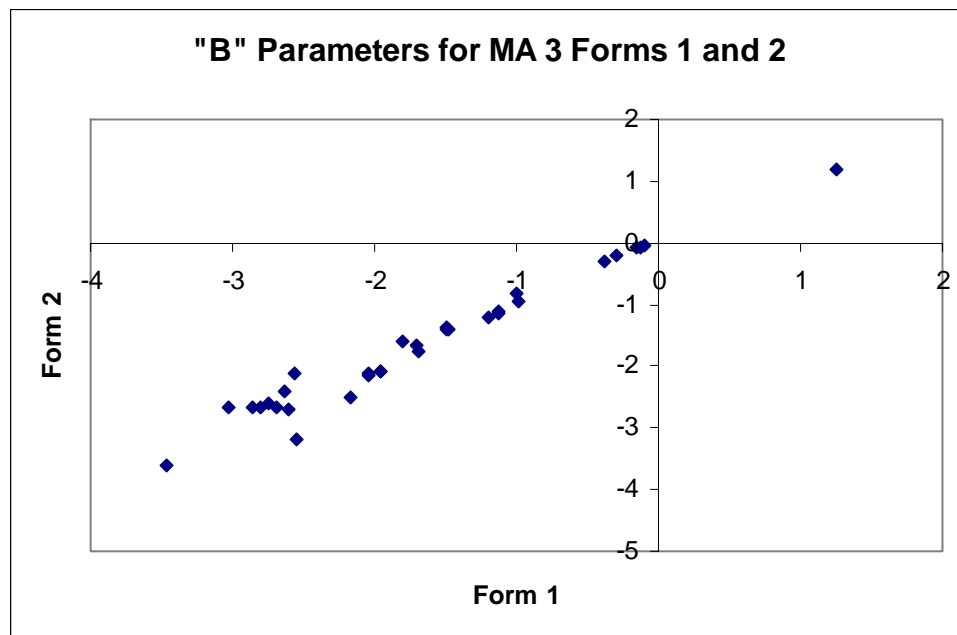
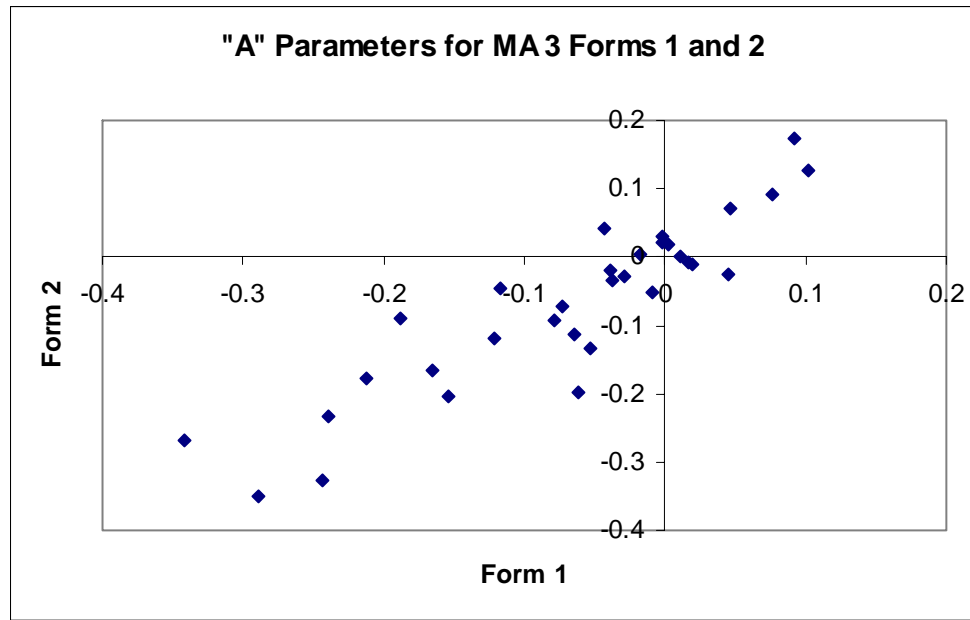

Figure 2. 2005 Grade 4 Common Item Parameter Comparison, Form 1 vs. Form 2

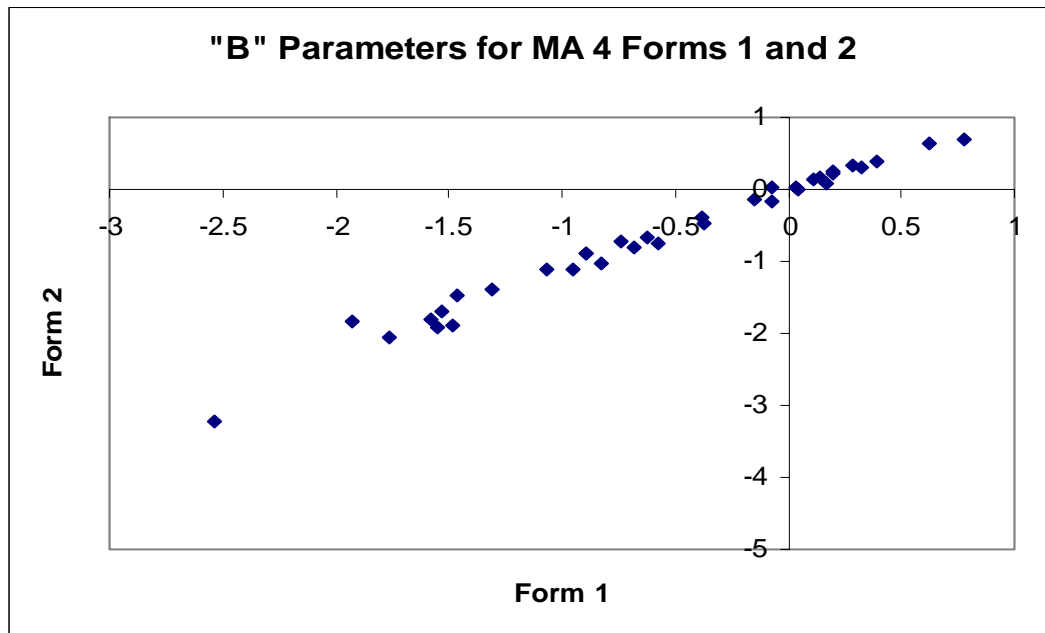
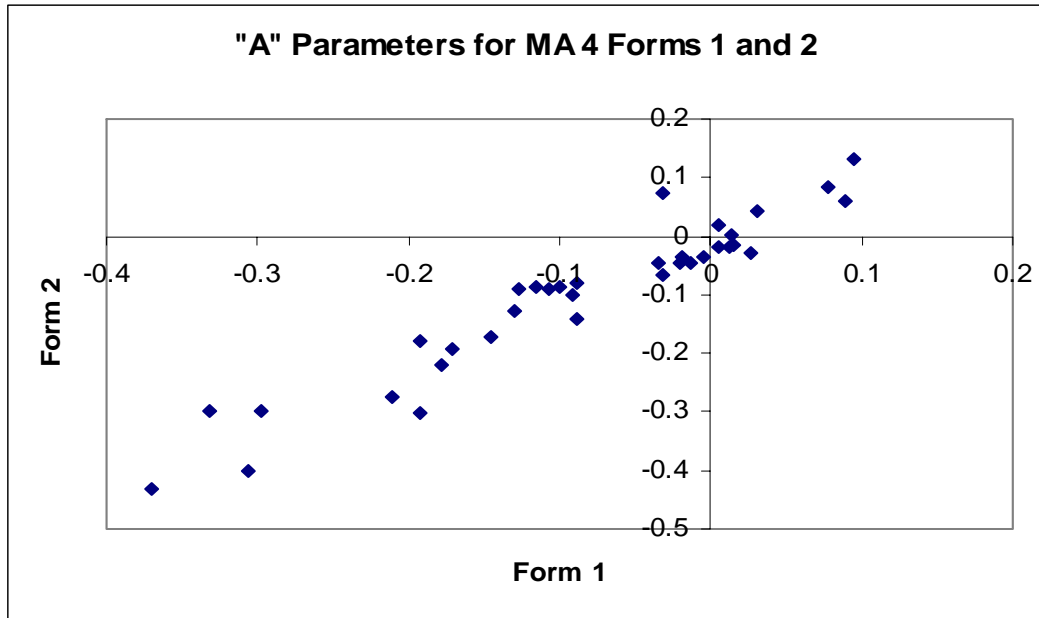

Figure 3. 2005 Grade 5 Common Item Parameter Comparison, Form 1 vs. Form 2

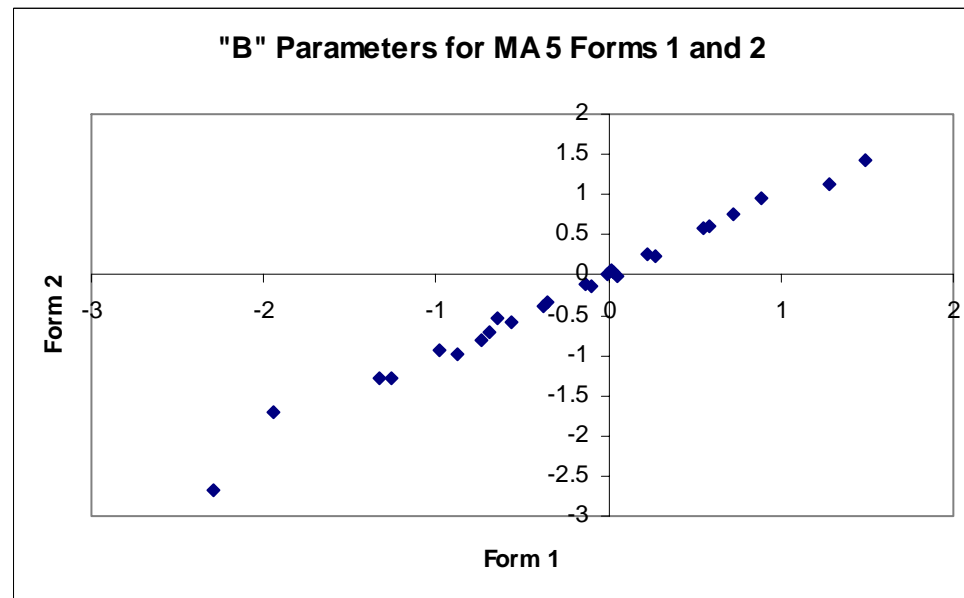
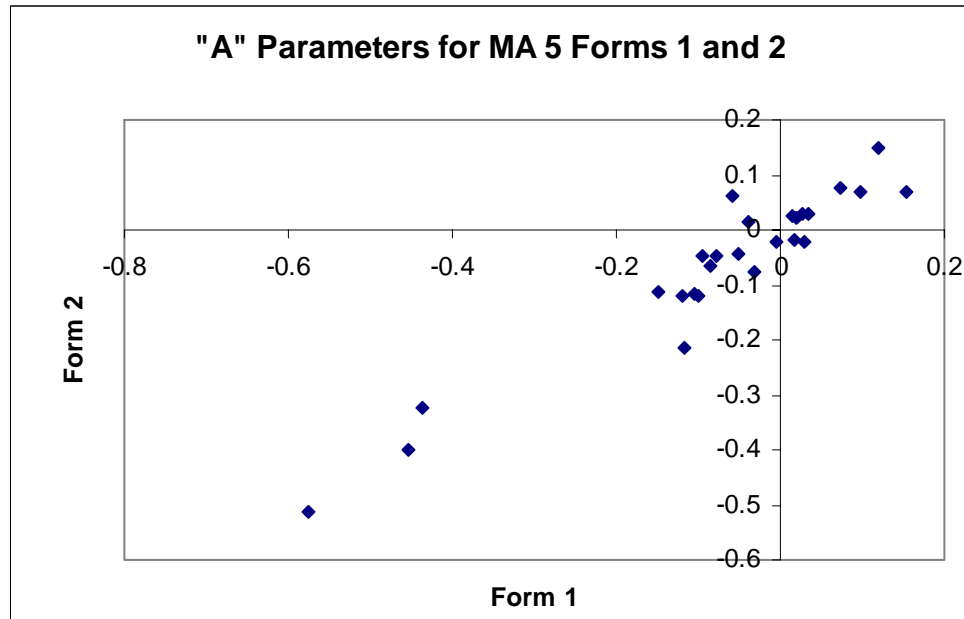

Figure 4. 2005 Grade 6 Common Item Parameter Comparison, Form 1 vs. Form 2

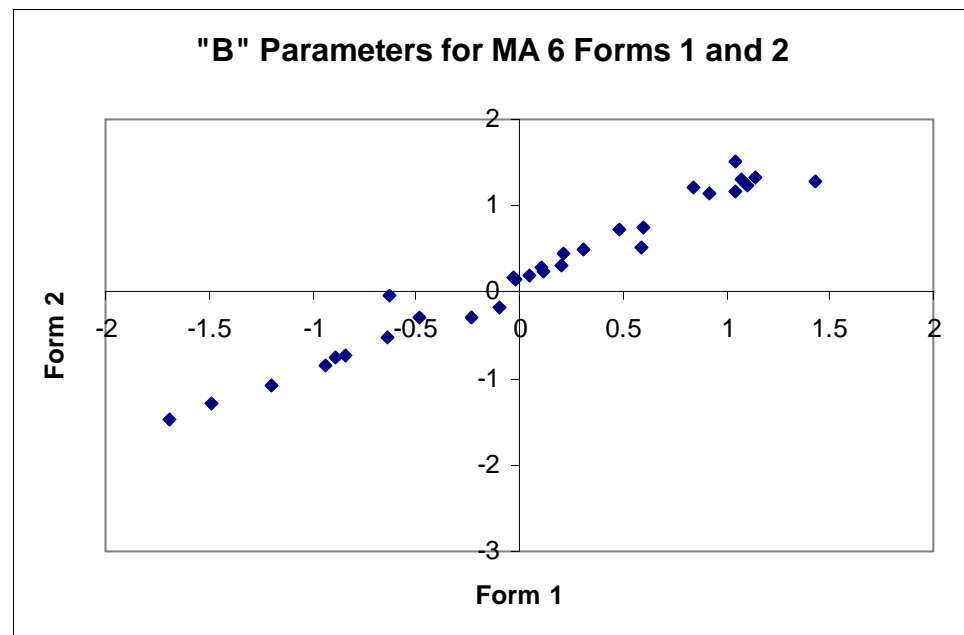
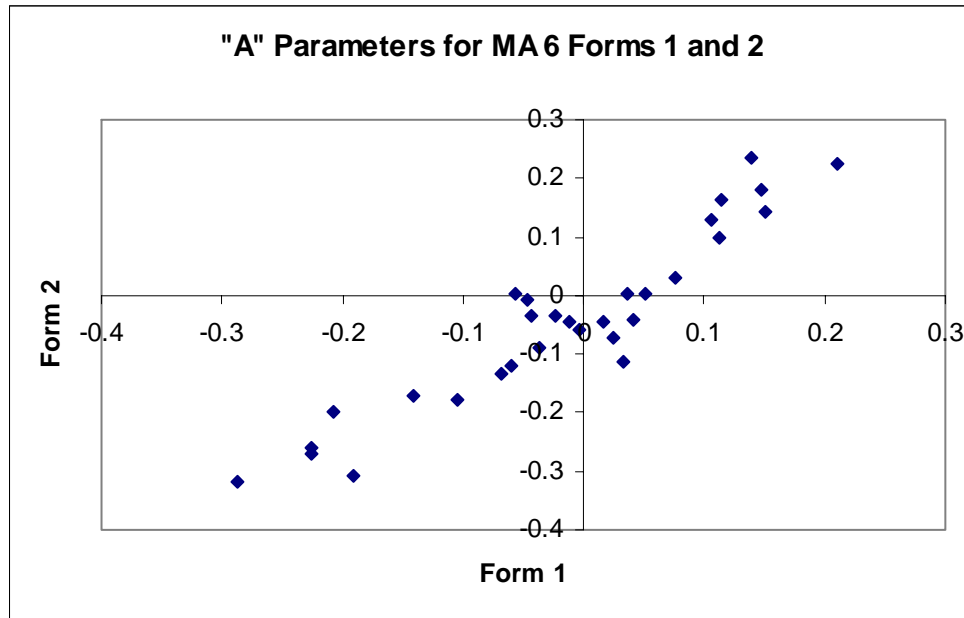

Figure 5. 2005 Grade 7 Common Item Parameter Comparison, Form 1 vs. Form 2

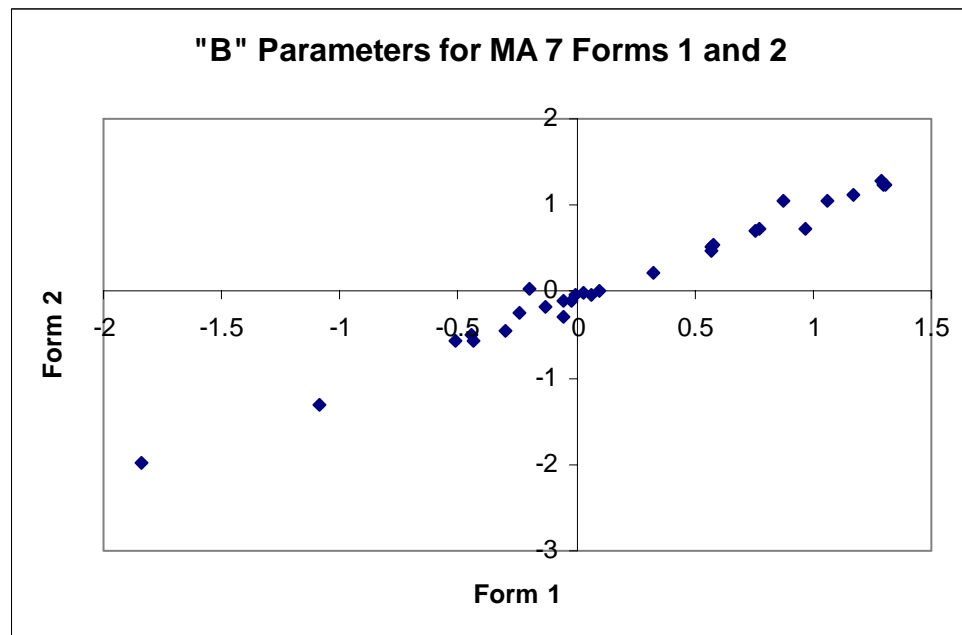
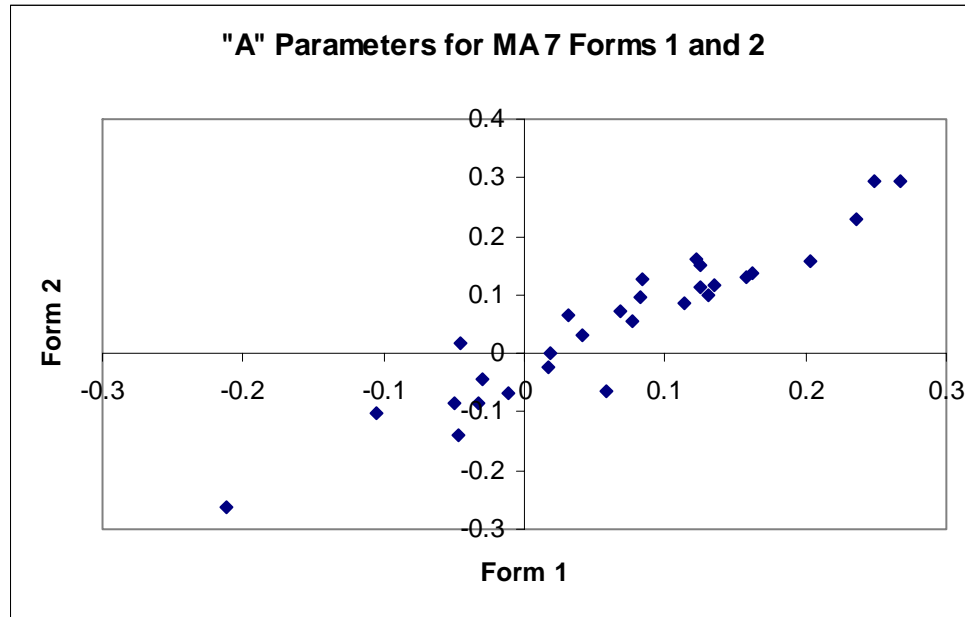

Figure 6. 2005 Grade 8 Common Item Parameter Comparison, Form 1 vs. Form 2

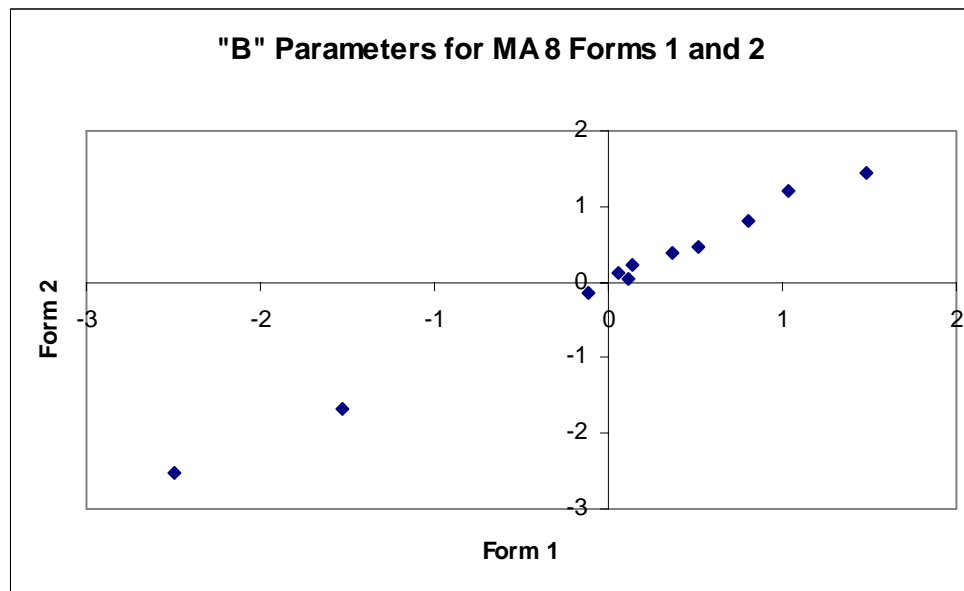
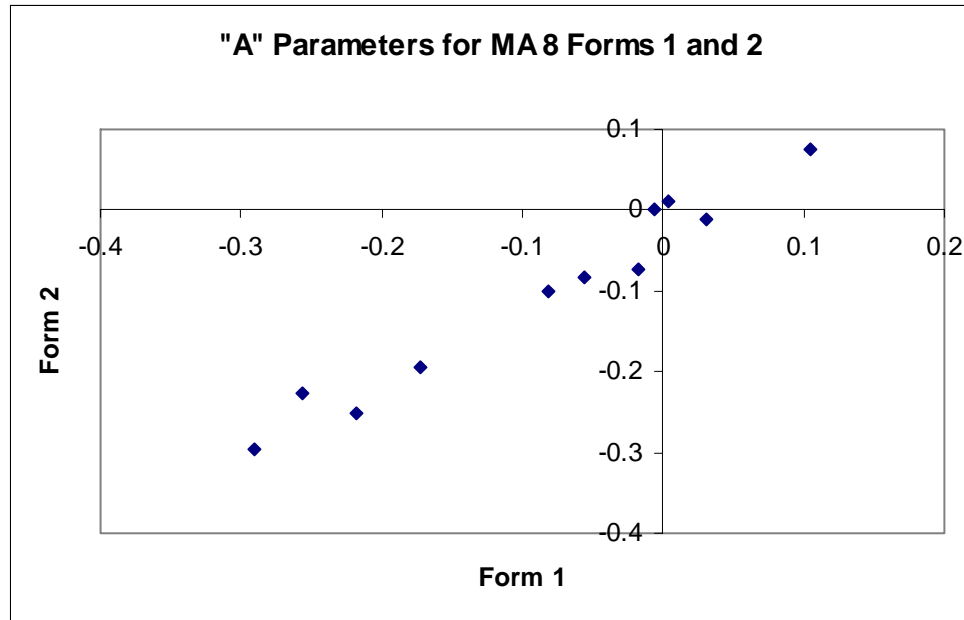

Figure 7. Estimated and Anchor A Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 3 Mathematics

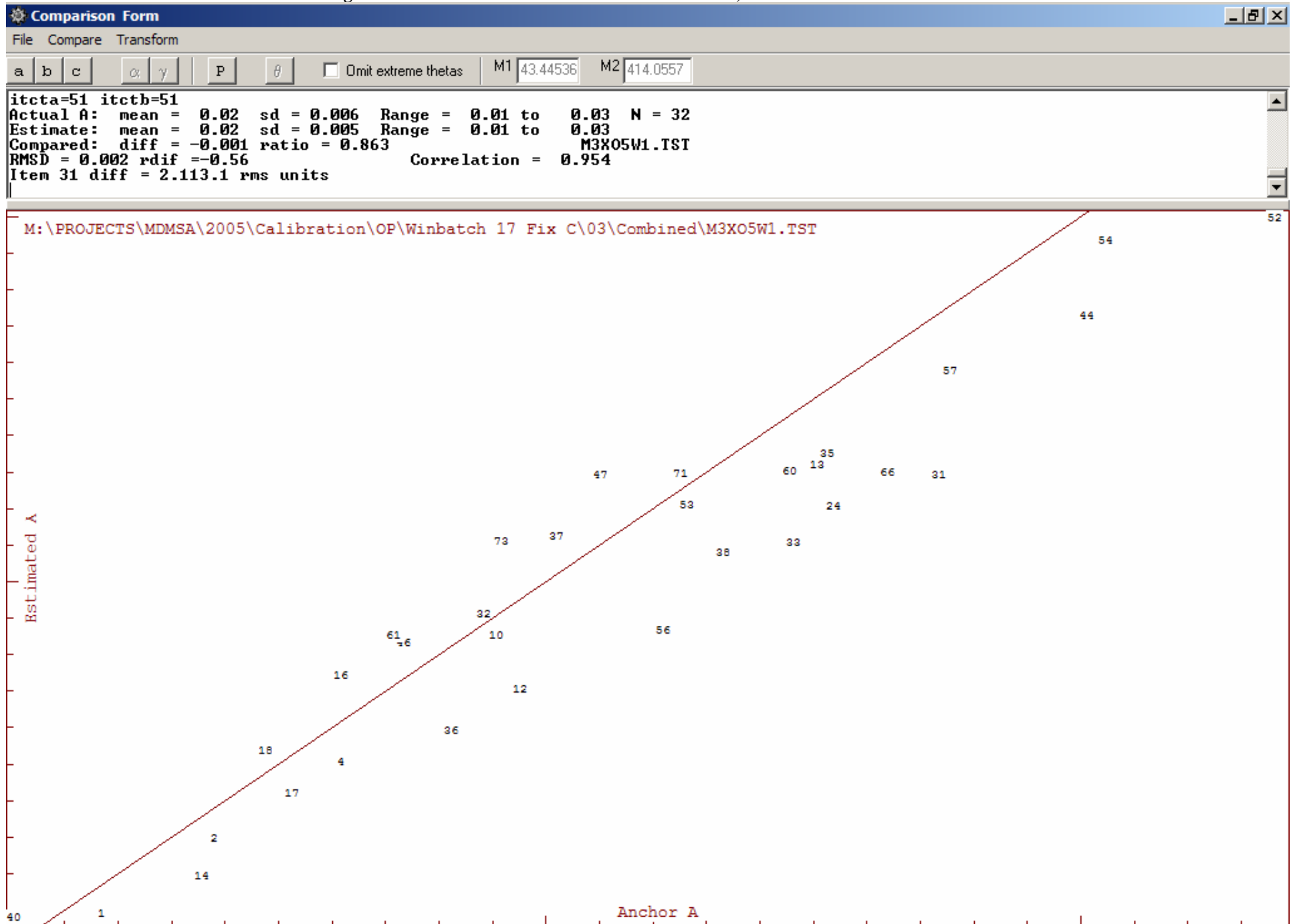


Figure 8. Estimated and Anchor B Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 3 Mathematics

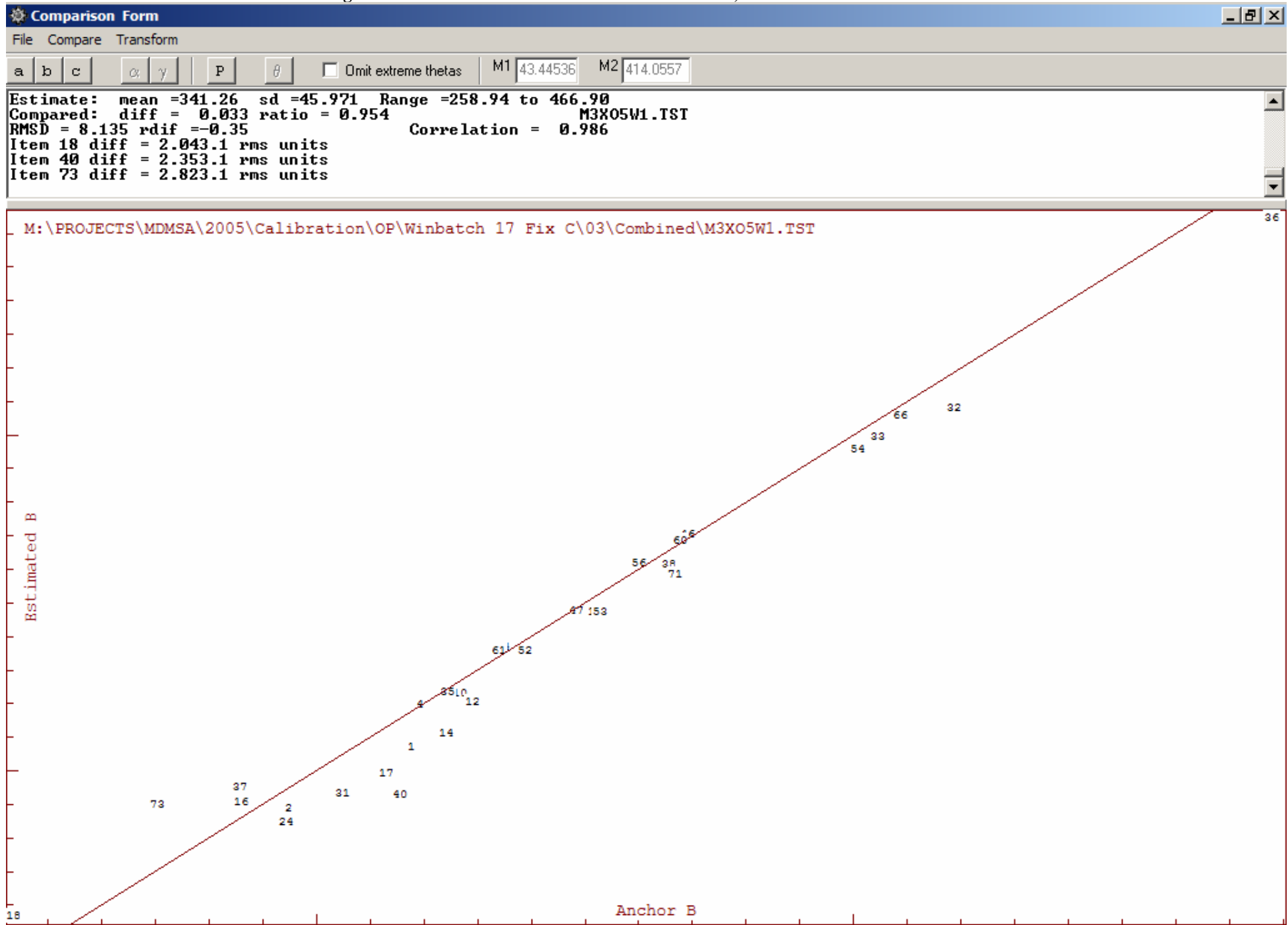


Figure 9. Estimated and Actual P Values, 2005 MSA Grade 3 Mathematics

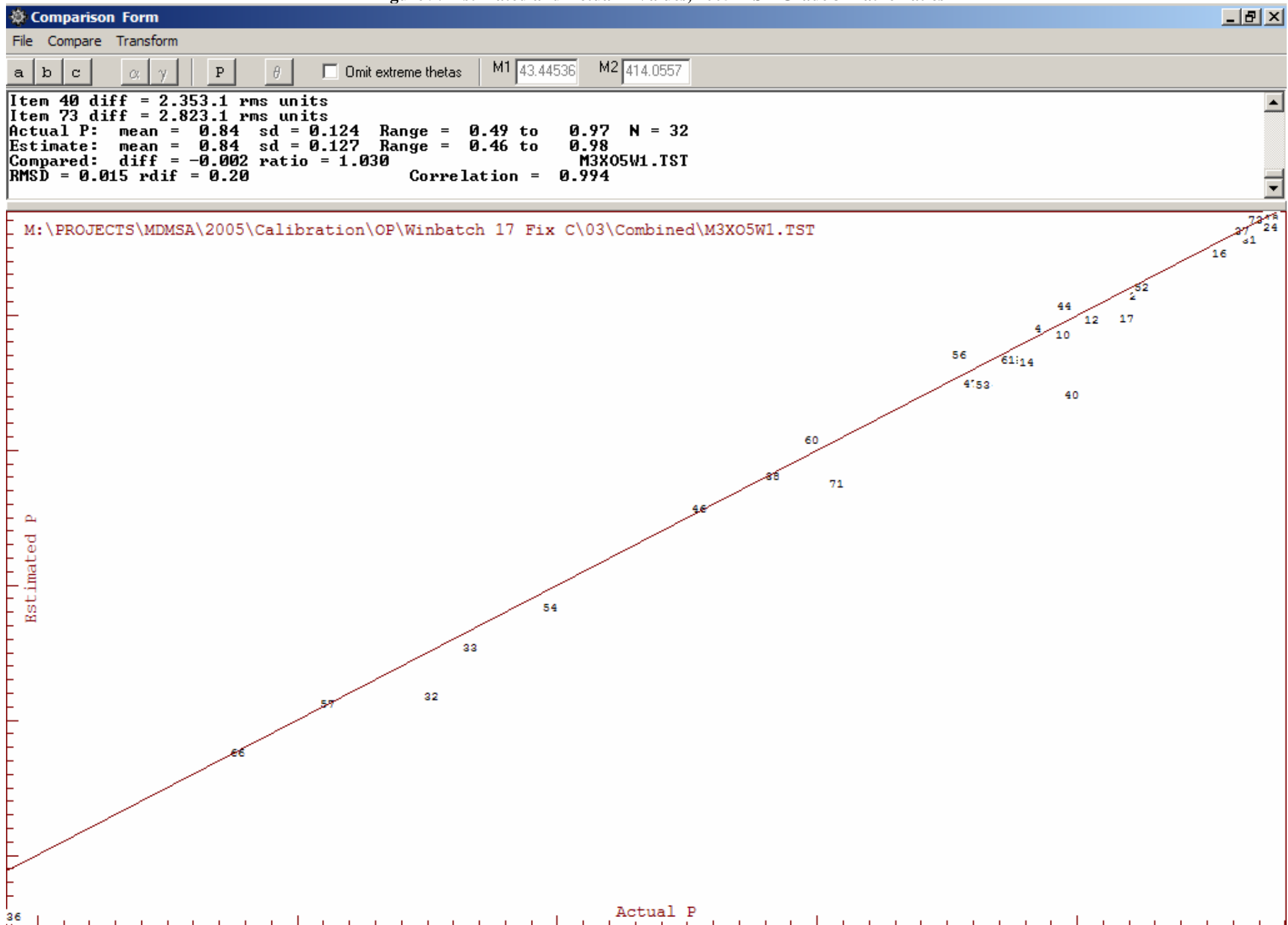


Figure 10. Stocking & Lord Test Characteristic Curves, 2005 MSA Grade 3 Mathematics

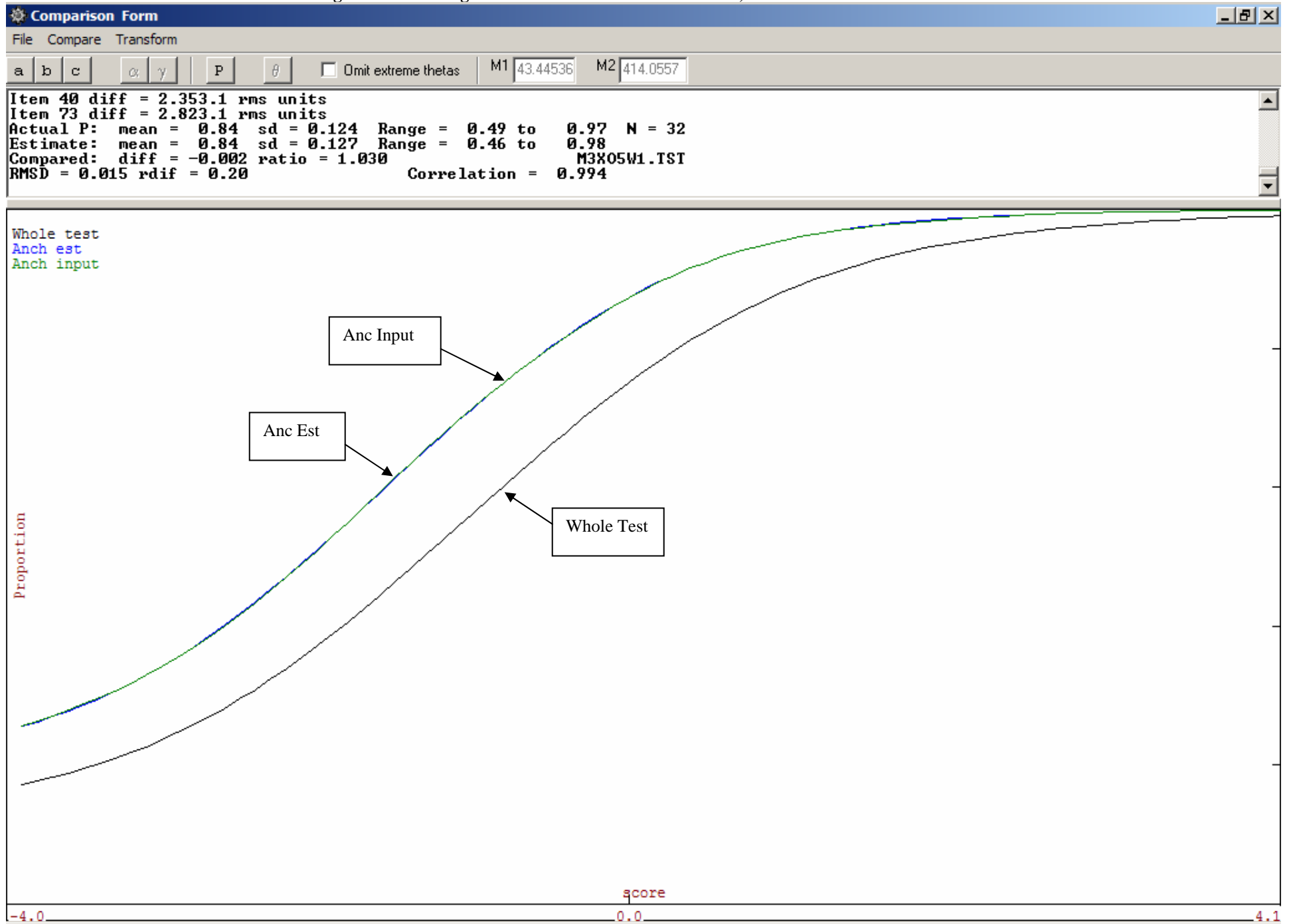


Figure 11. Estimated and Anchor A Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 4 Mathematics

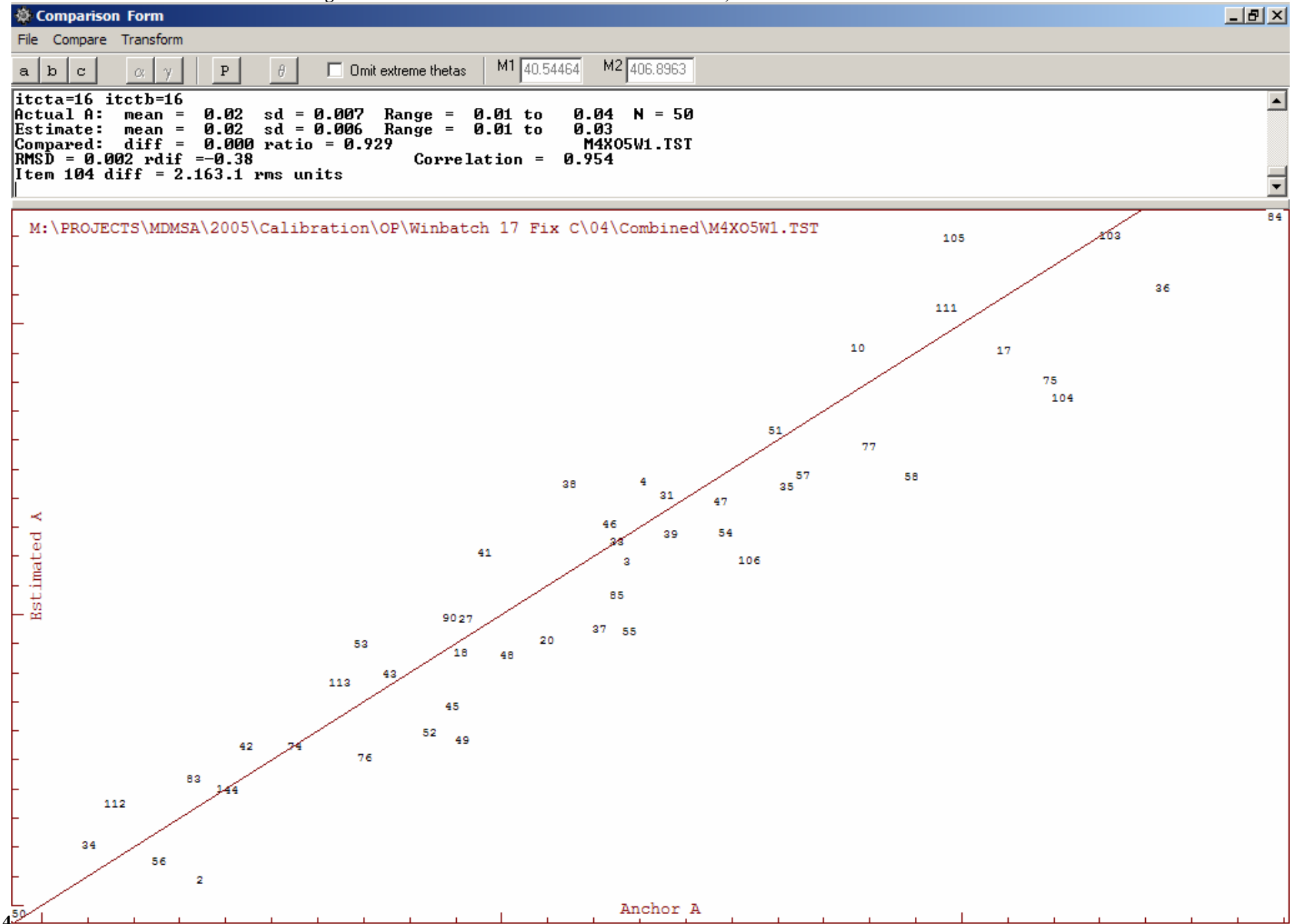


Figure 12. Estimated and Anchor B Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 4 Mathematics

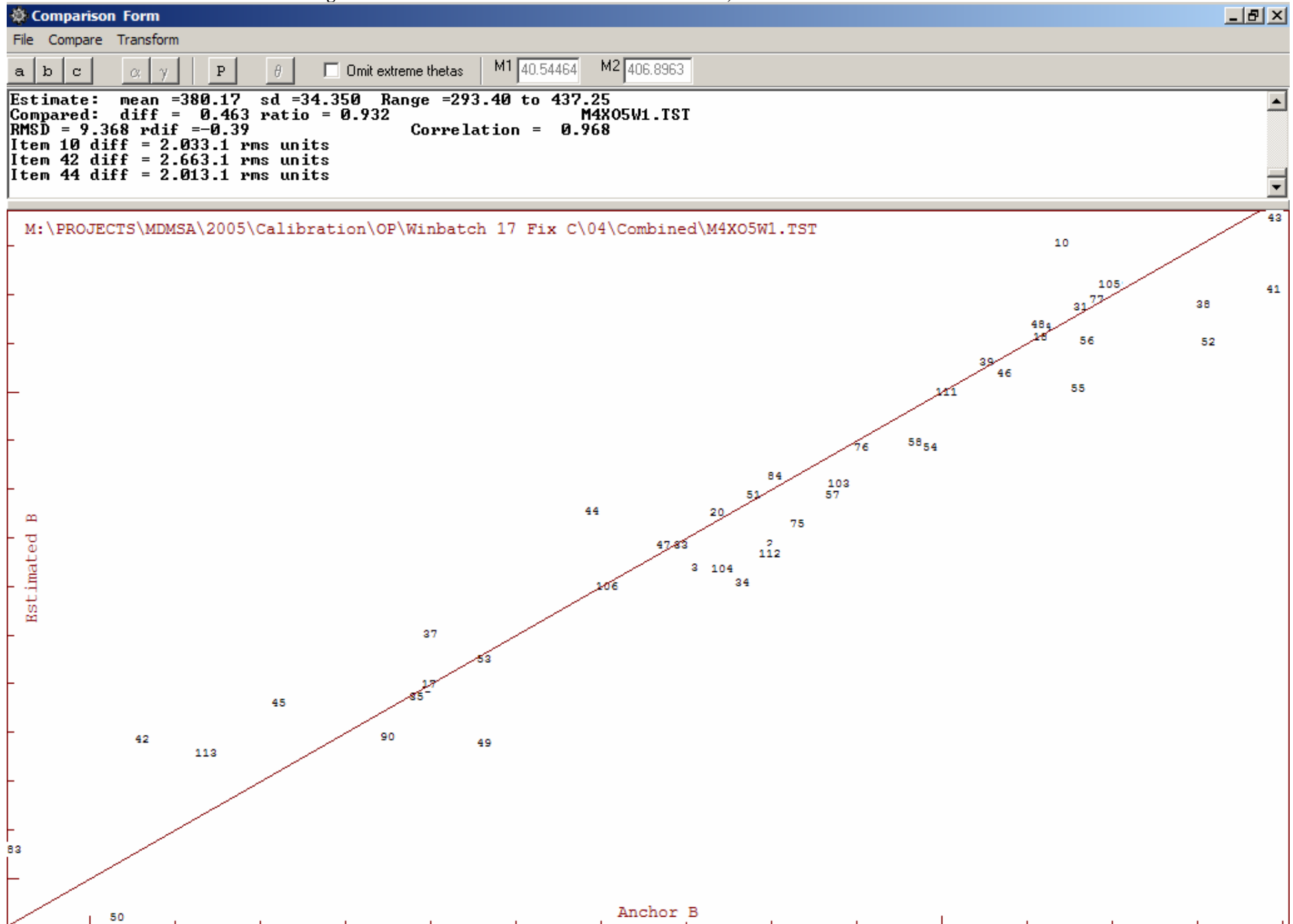


Figure 13. Estimated and Actual P Values, 2005 MSA Grade 4 Mathematics

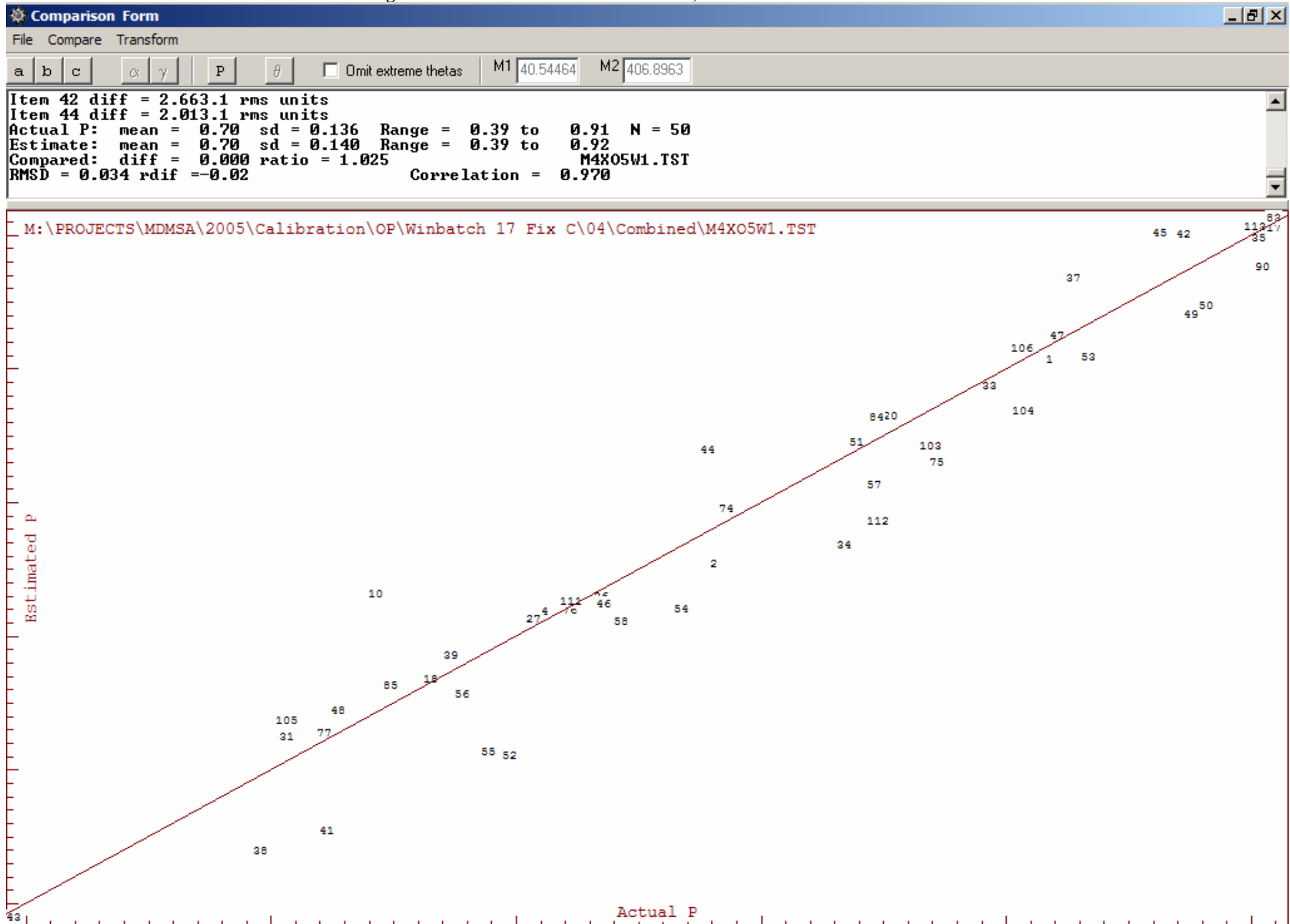


Figure 14. Stocking & Lord Test Characteristic Curves, 2005 MSA Grade 4 Mathematics

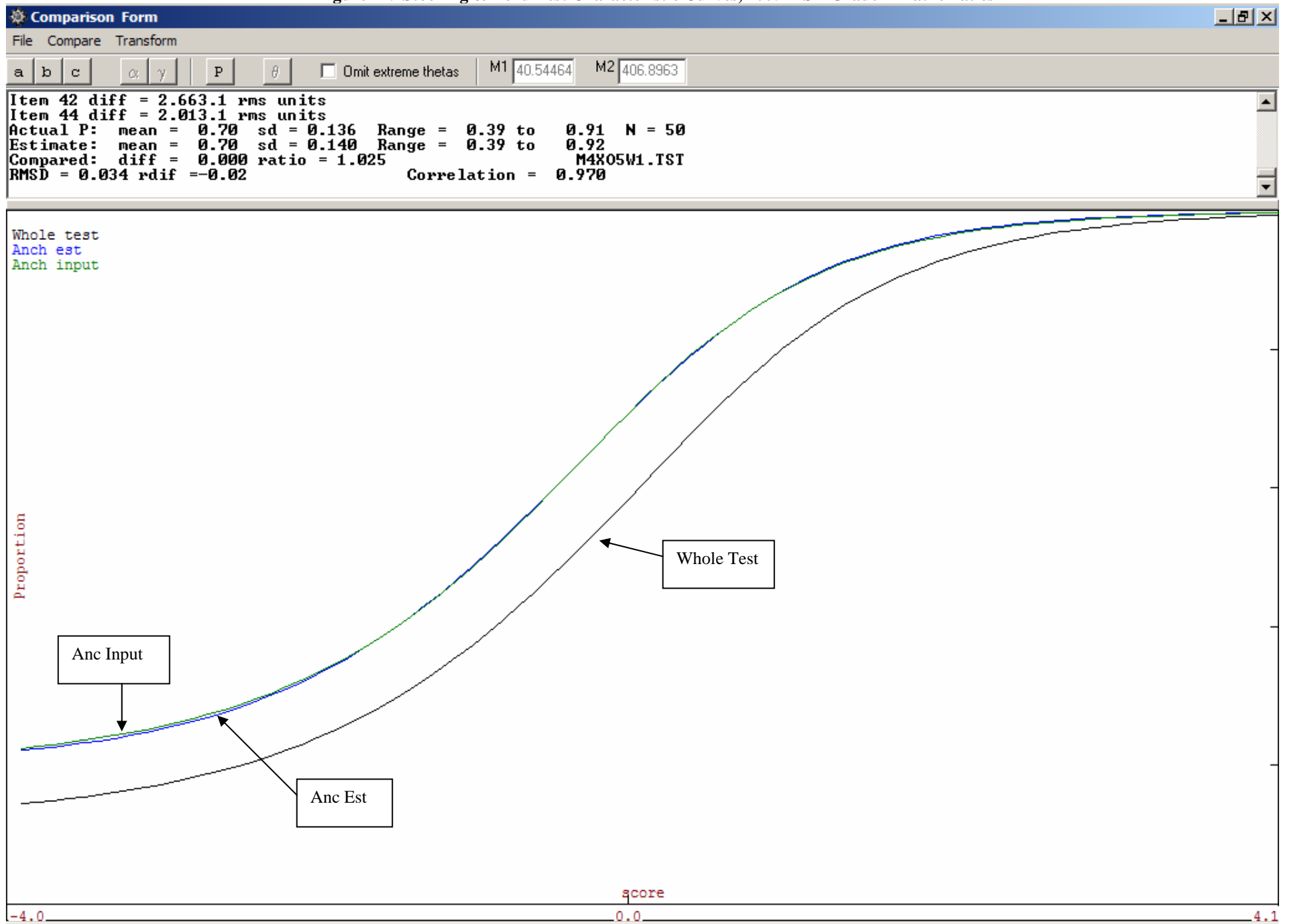


Figure 15. Estimated and Anchor A Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 5 Mathematics

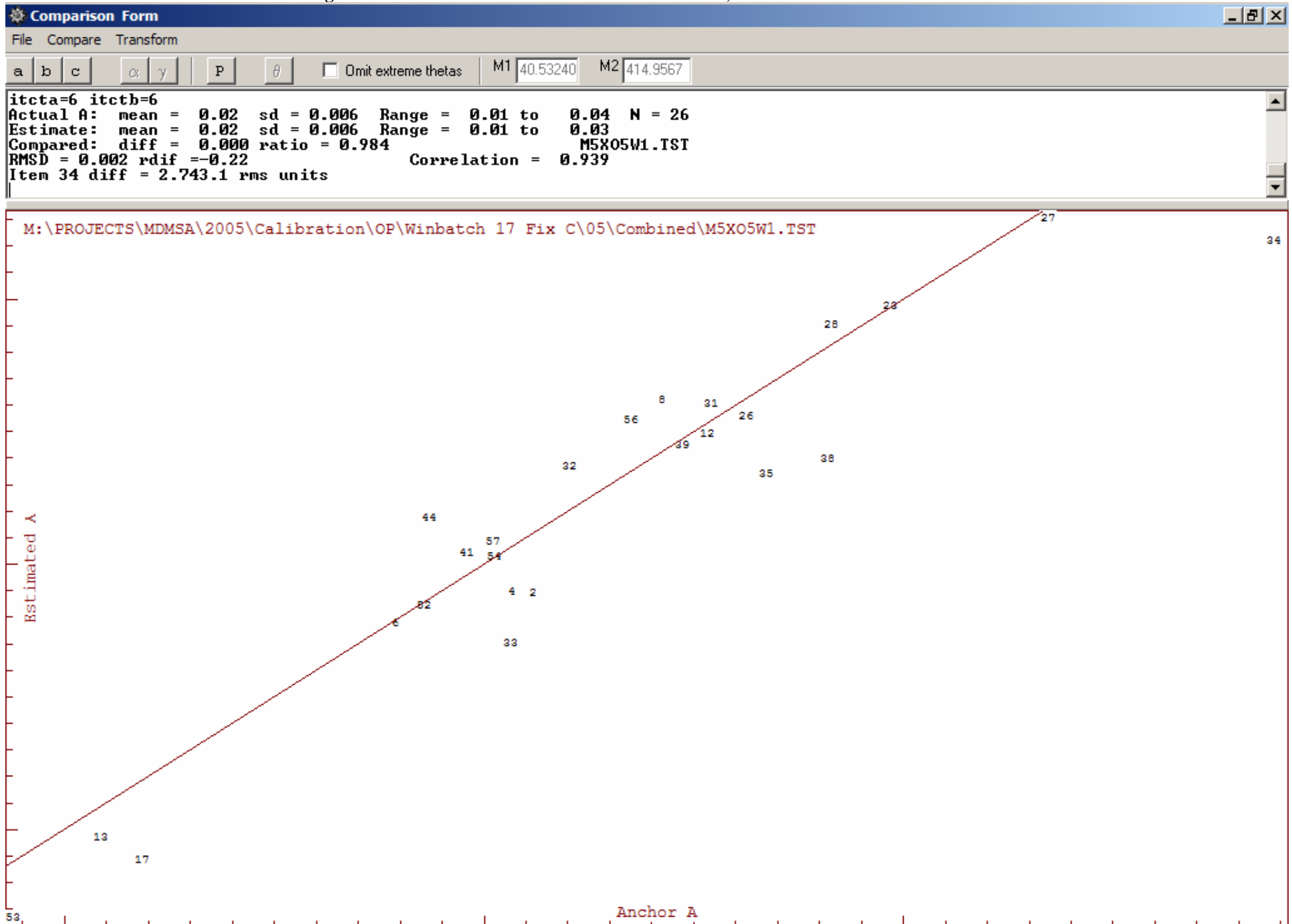


Figure 16. Estimated and Anchor B Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 5 Mathematics

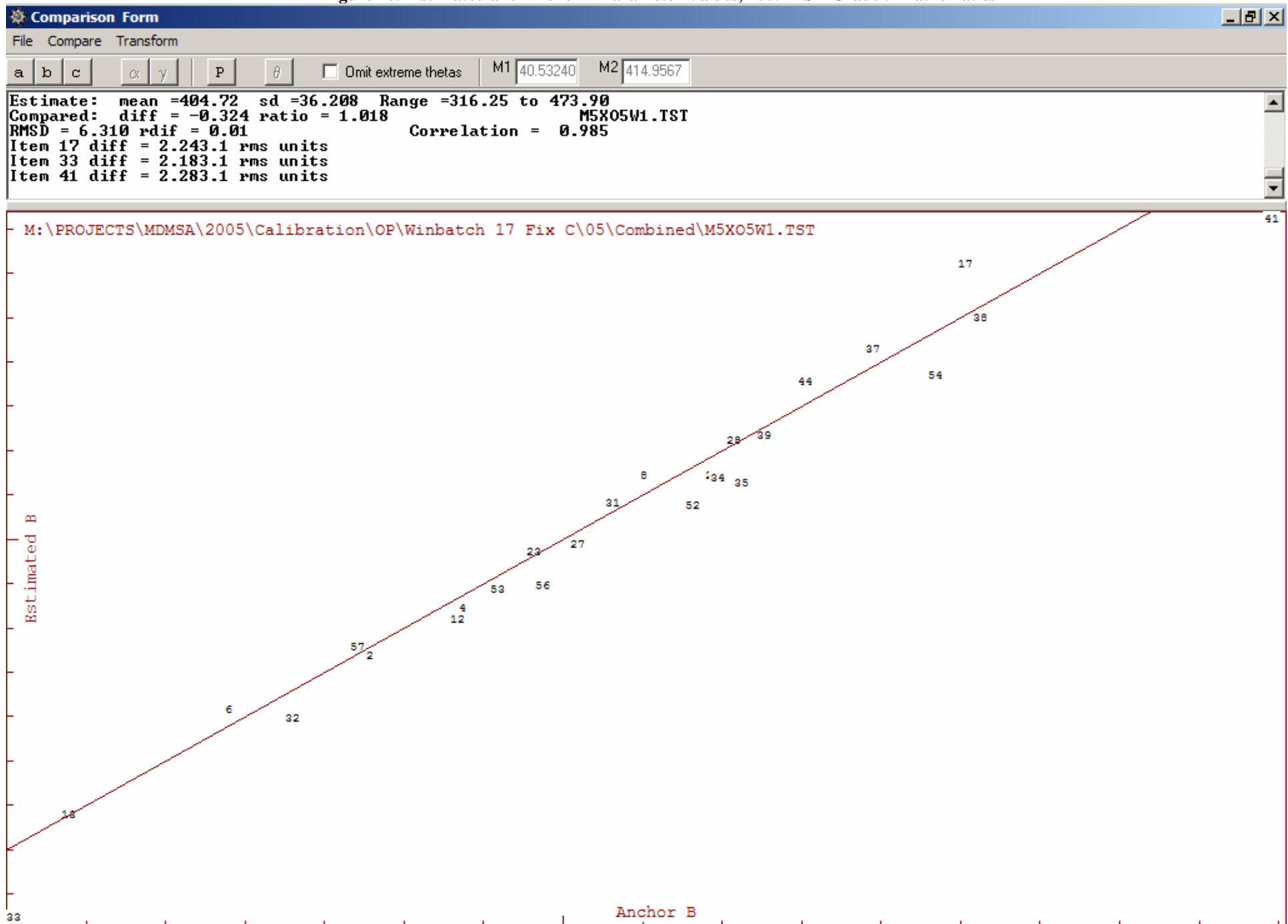


Figure 17. Estimated and Actual P Values, 2005 MSA Grade 5 Mathematics

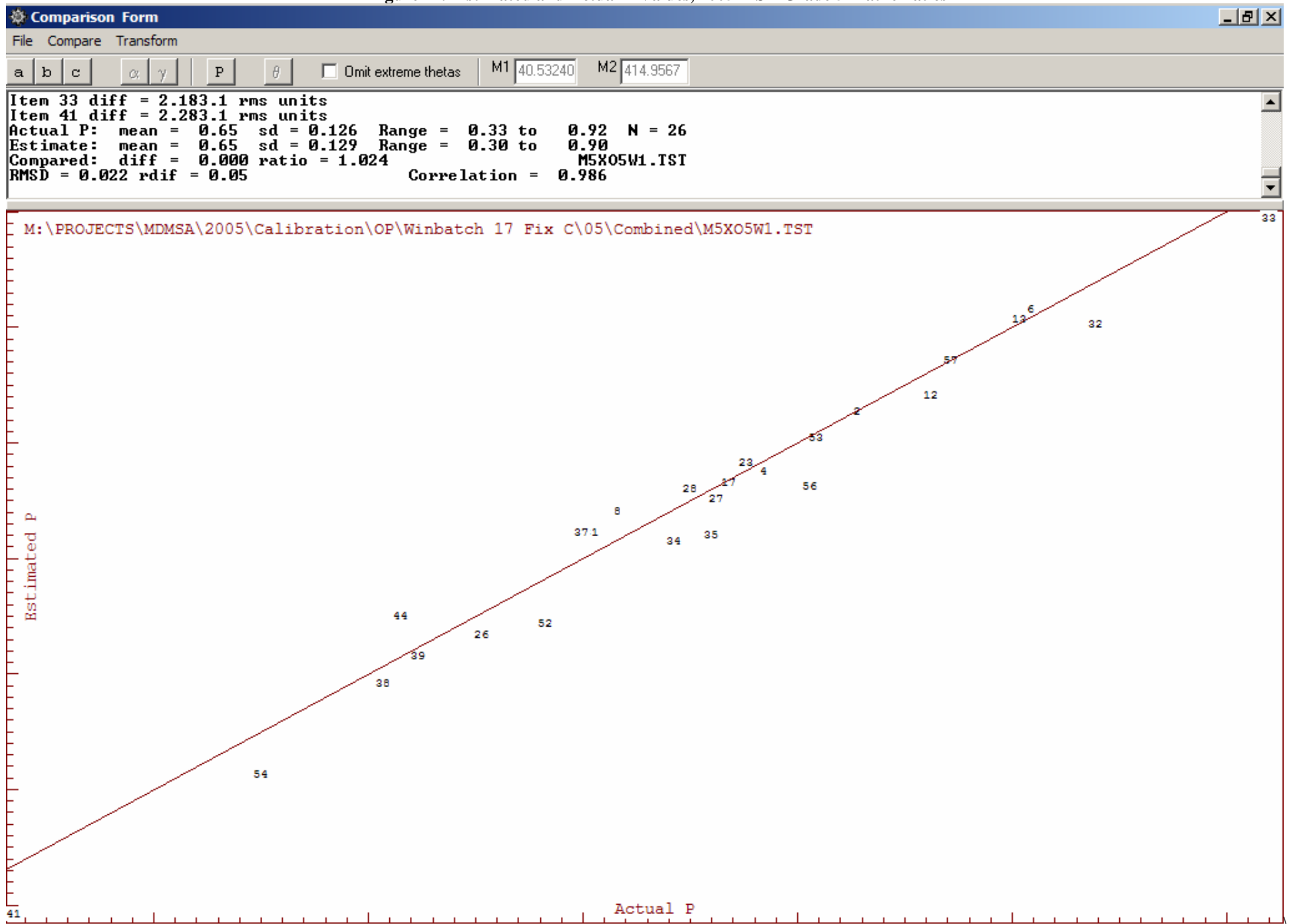


Figure 18. Stocking & Lord Test Characteristic Curves, 2005 MSA Grade 5 Mathematics

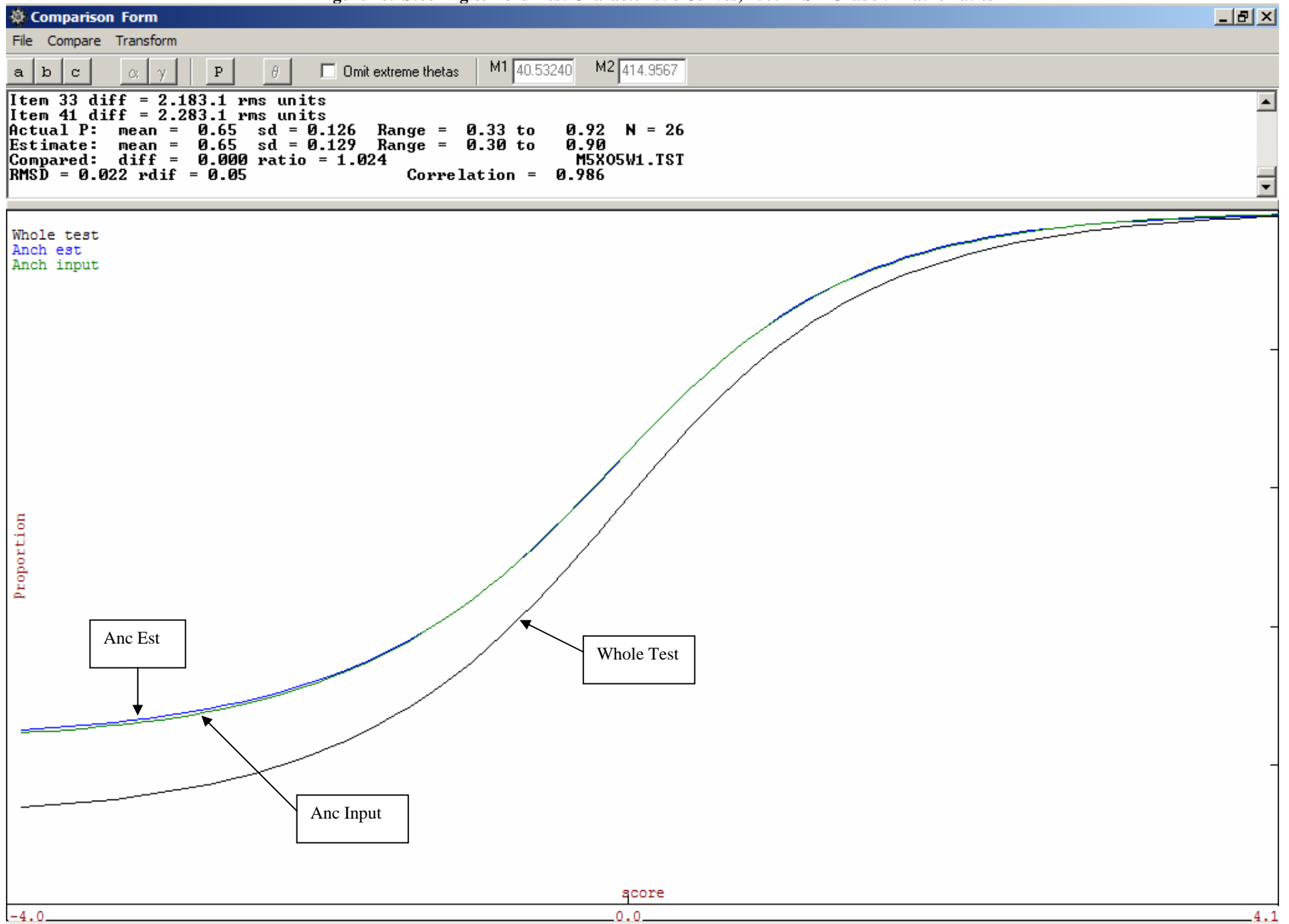


Figure 19. Estimated and Anchor A Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 6 Mathematics

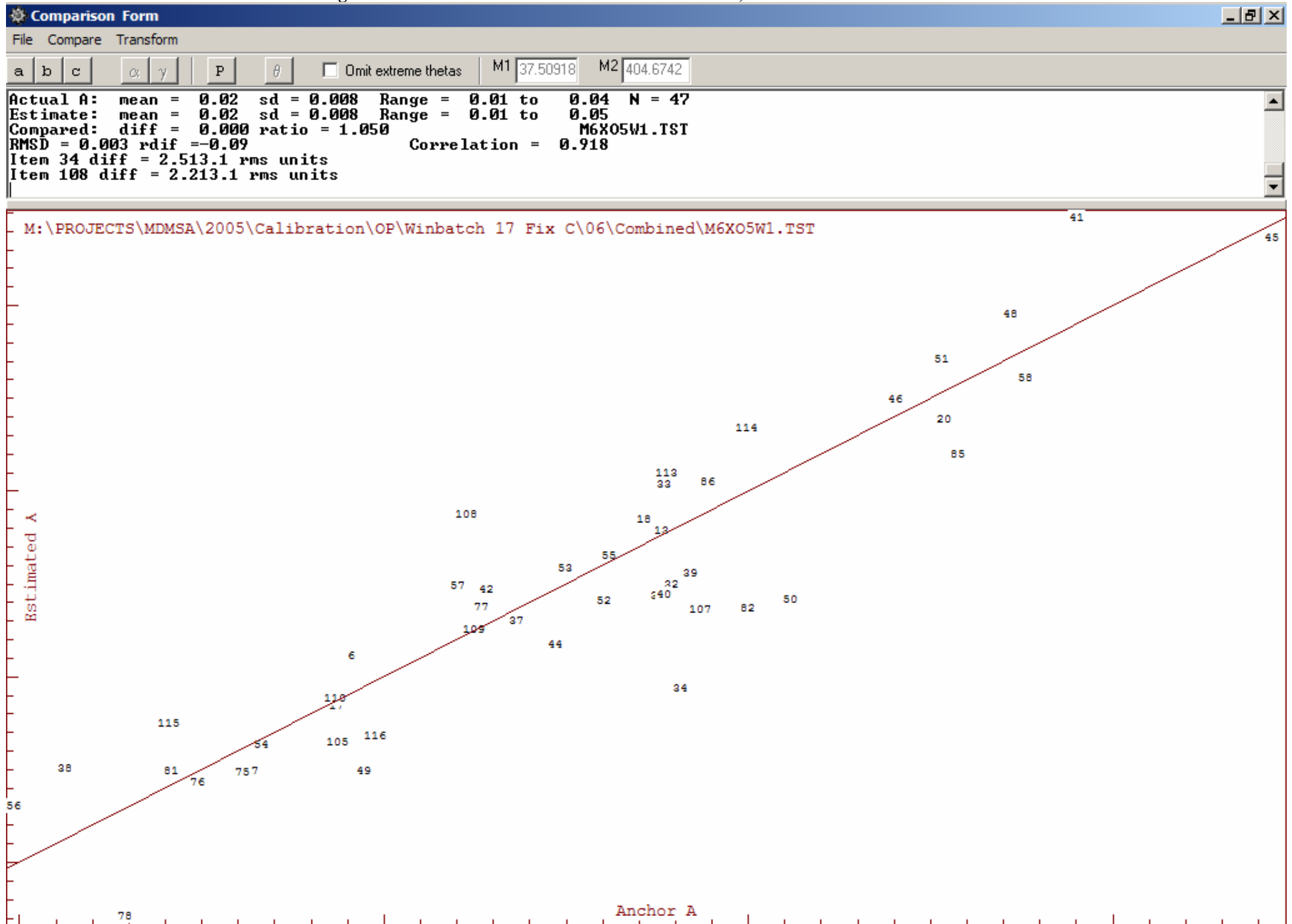


Figure 20. Estimated and Anchor B Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 6 Mathematics

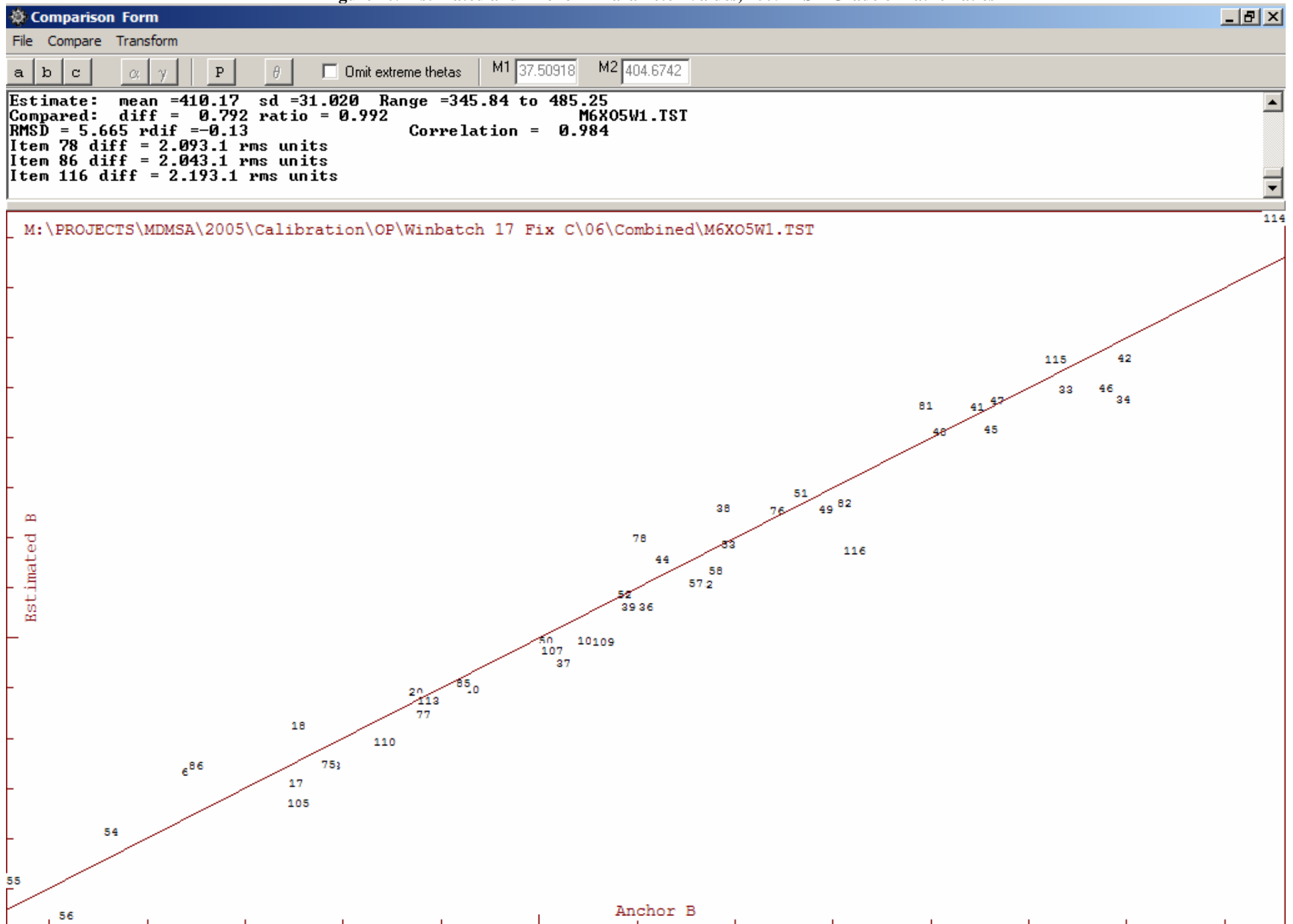


Figure 21. Estimated and Actual P Values, 2005 MSA Grade 6 Mathematics

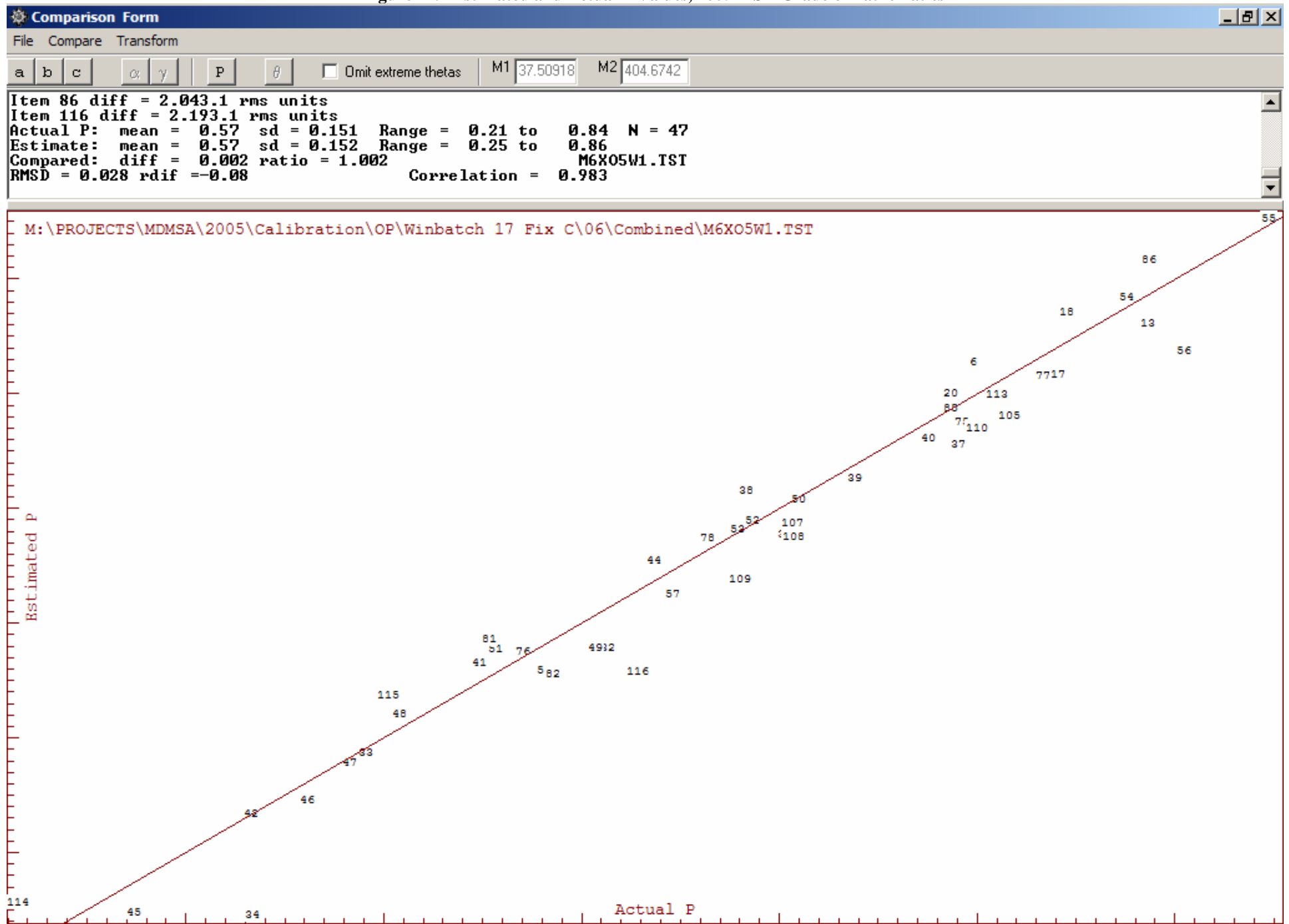


Figure 22. Stocking & Lord Test Characteristic Curves, 2005 MSA Grade 6 Mathematics

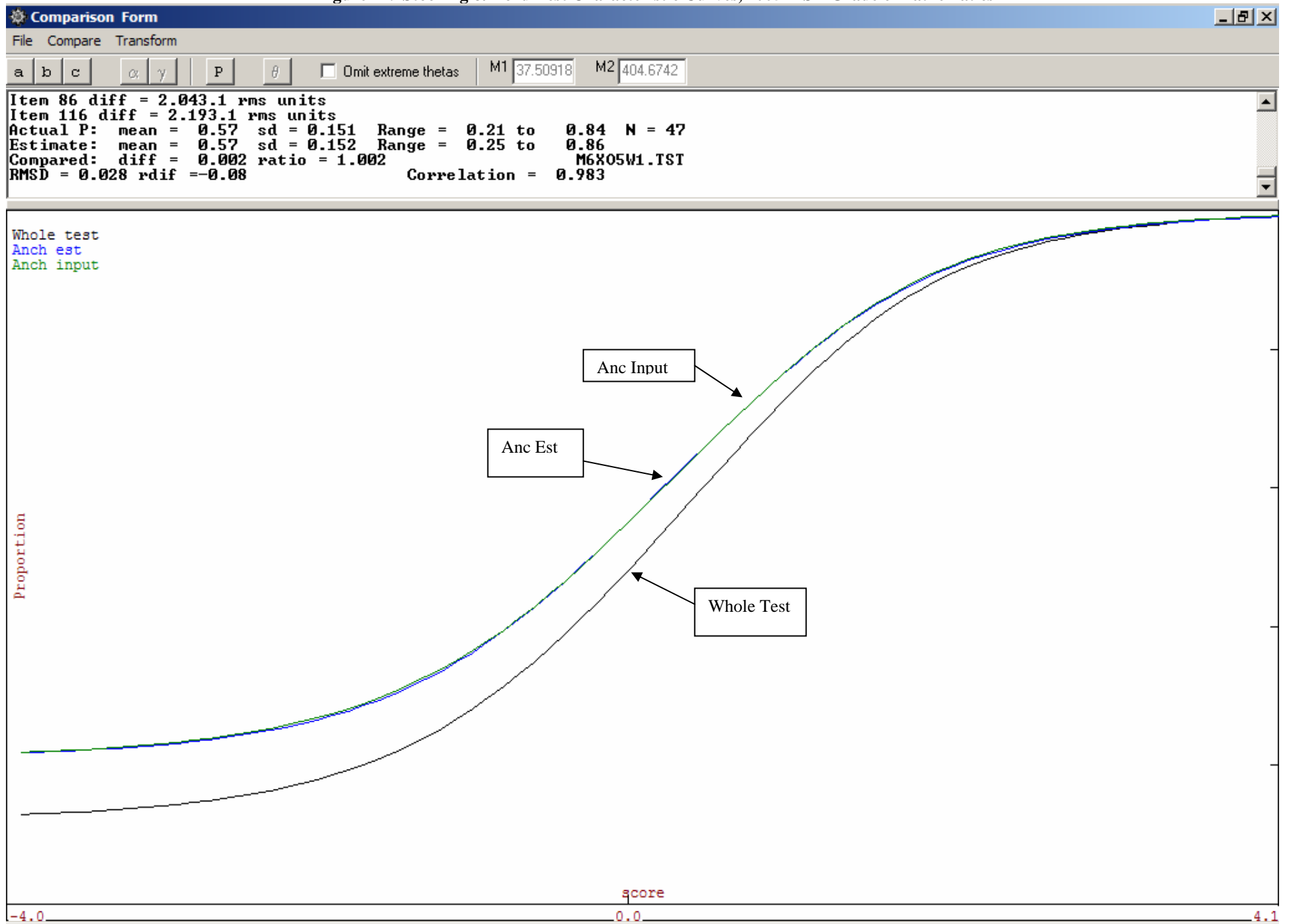


Figure 23. Estimated and Anchor A Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 7 Mathematics

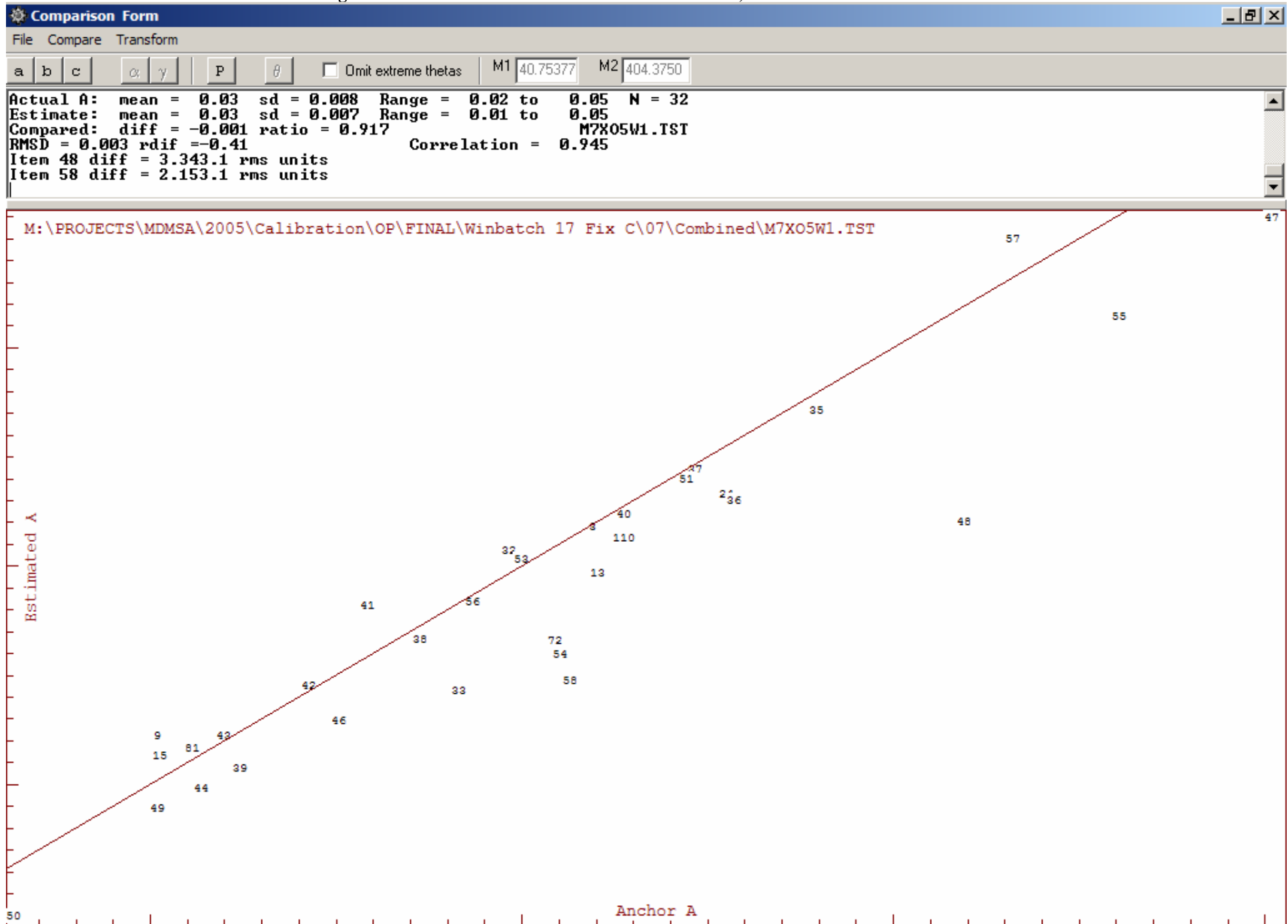


Figure 24. Estimated and Anchor B Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 7 Mathematics

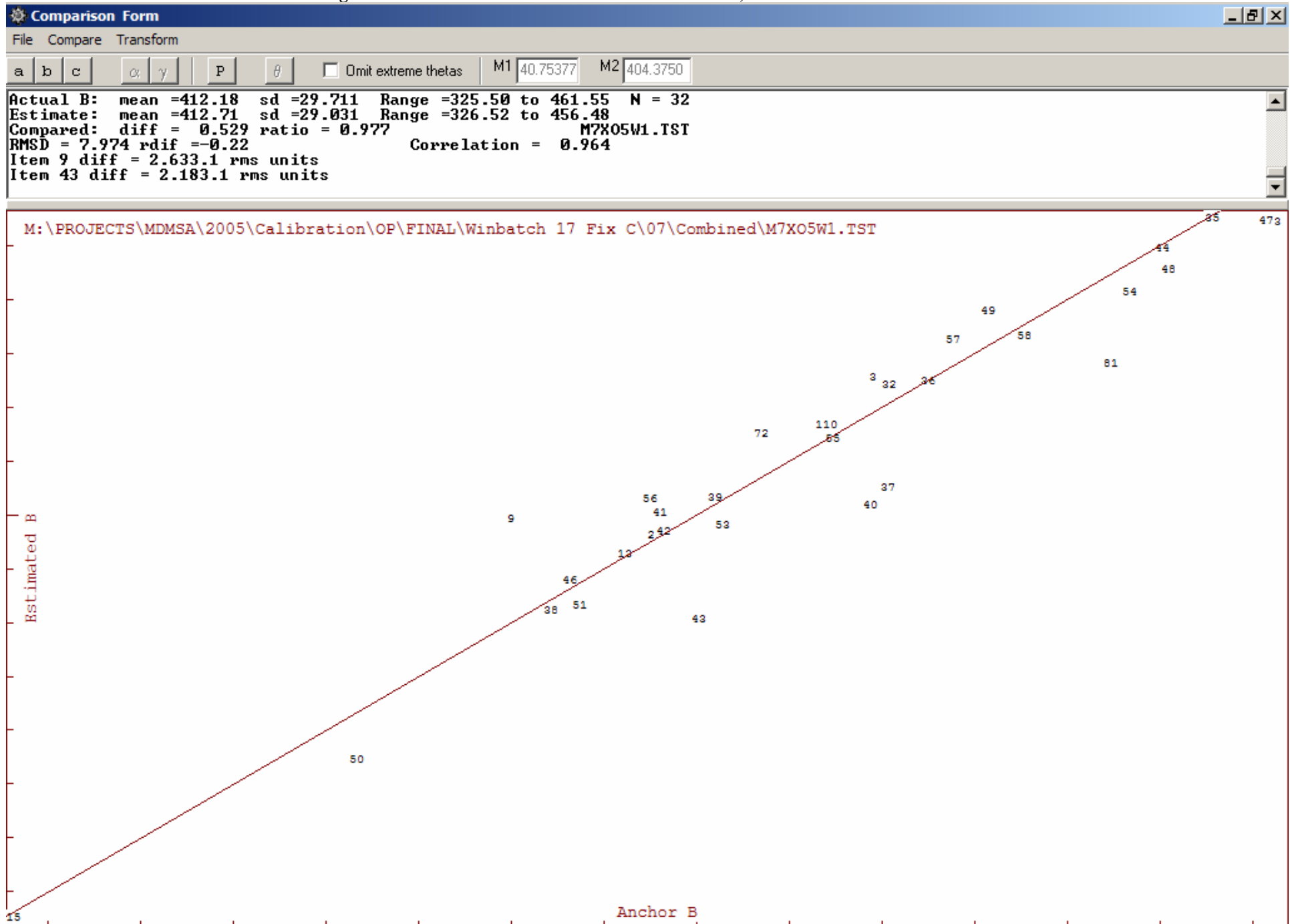


Figure 25. Estimated and Actual P Values, 2005 MSA Grade 7 Mathematics

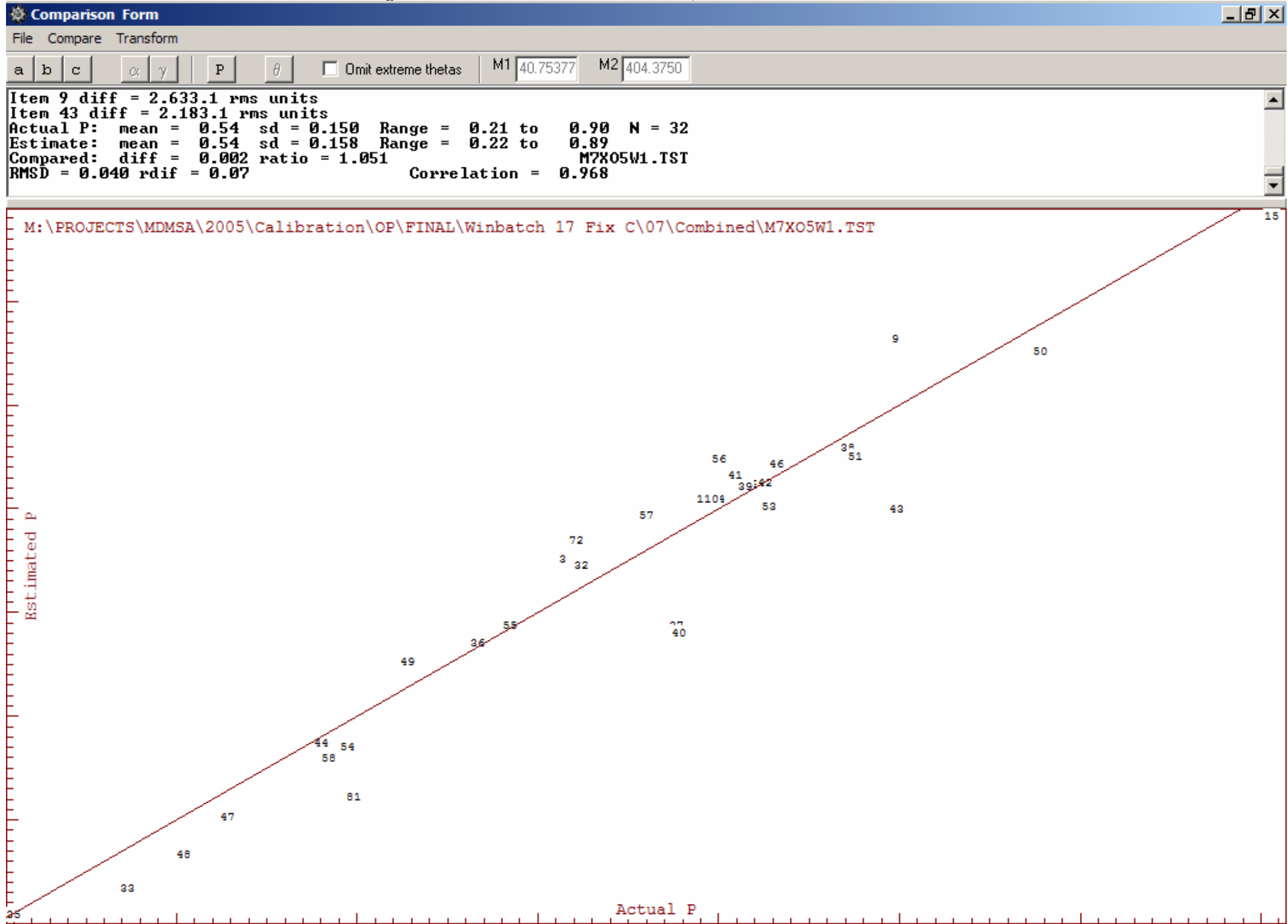


Figure 26. Stocking & Lord Test Characteristic Curves, 2005 MSA Grade 7 Mathematics

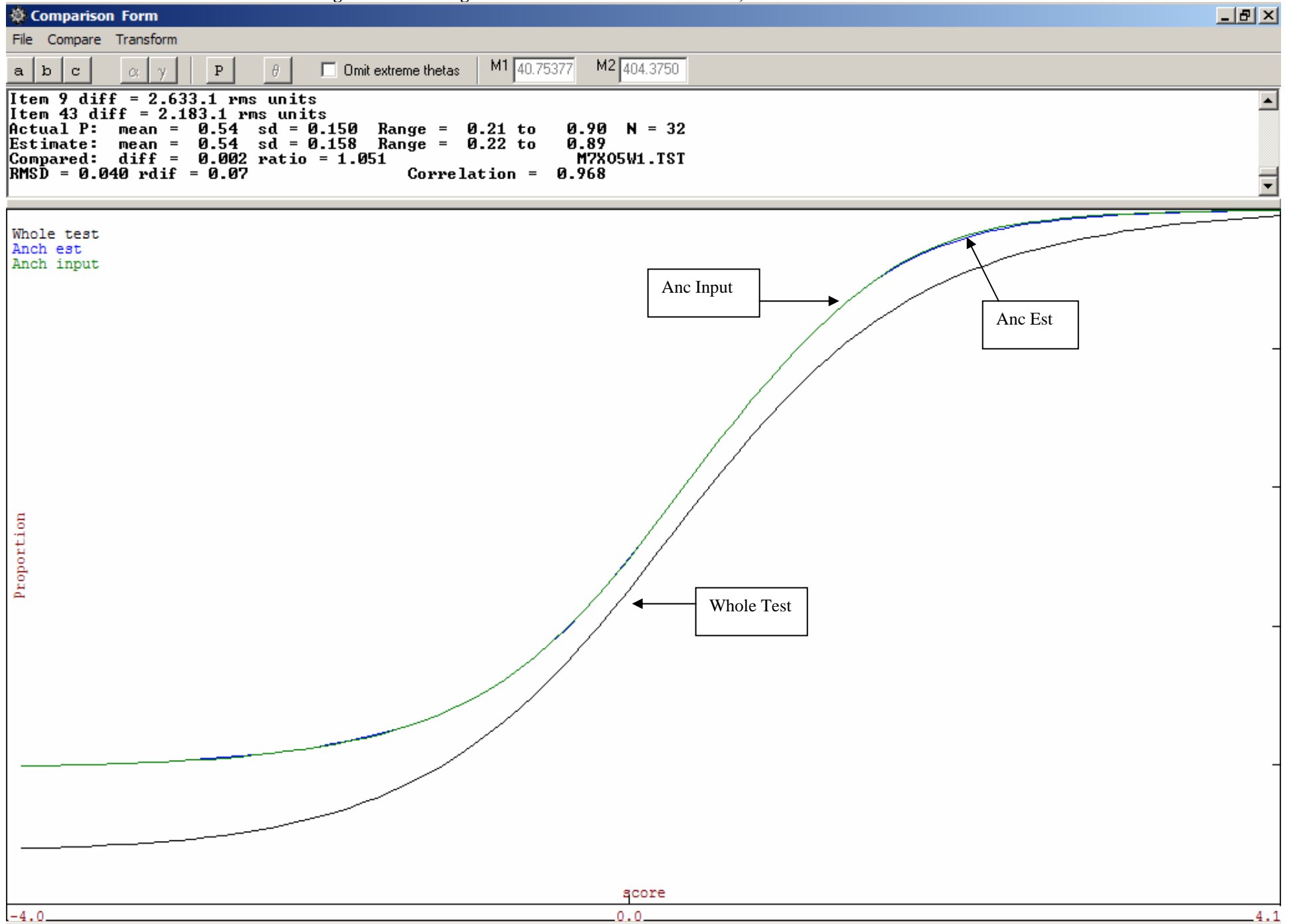


Figure 27. Estimated and Anchor A Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 8 Mathematics

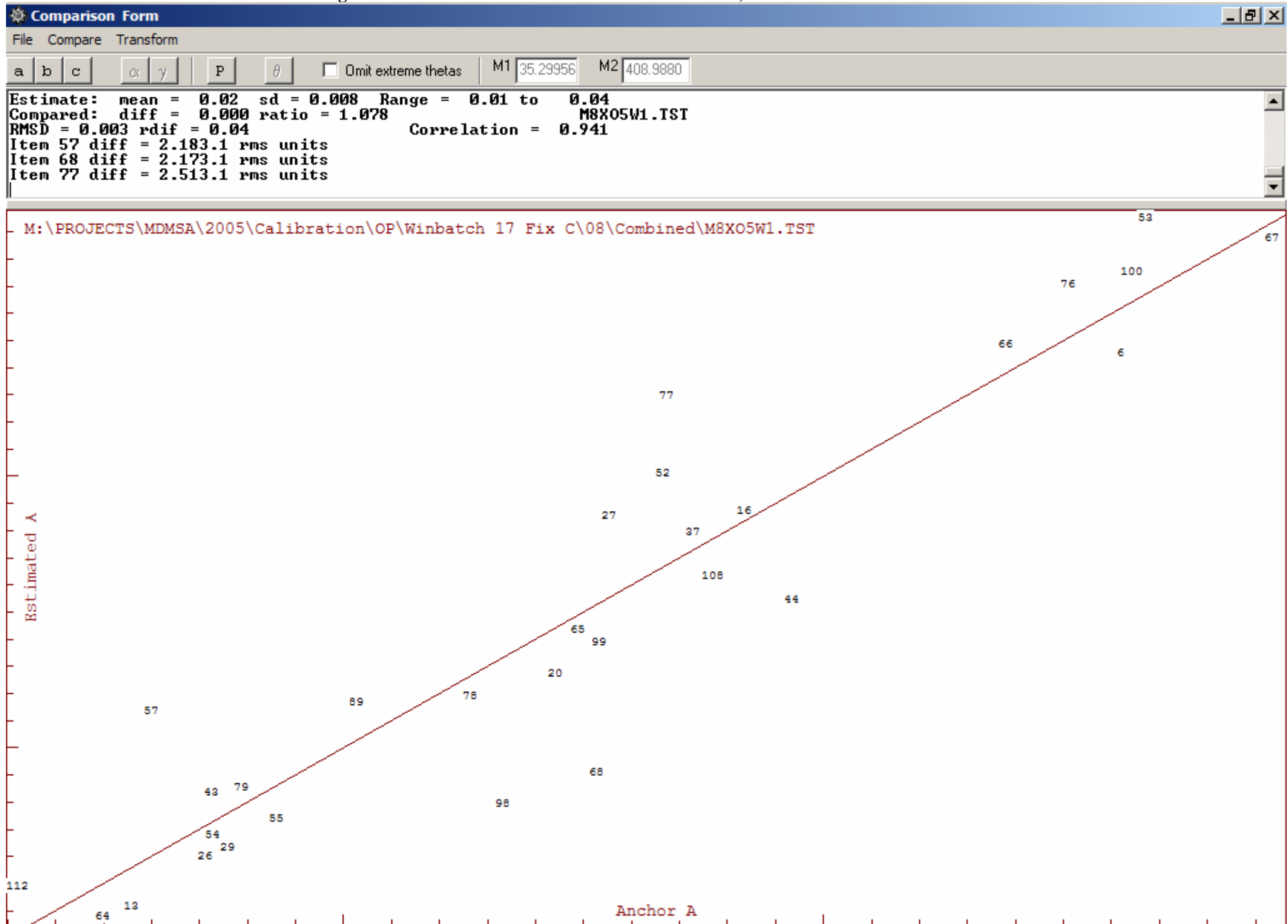


Figure 28. Estimated and Anchor B Parameter Values, 2005 MSA Grade 8 Mathematics

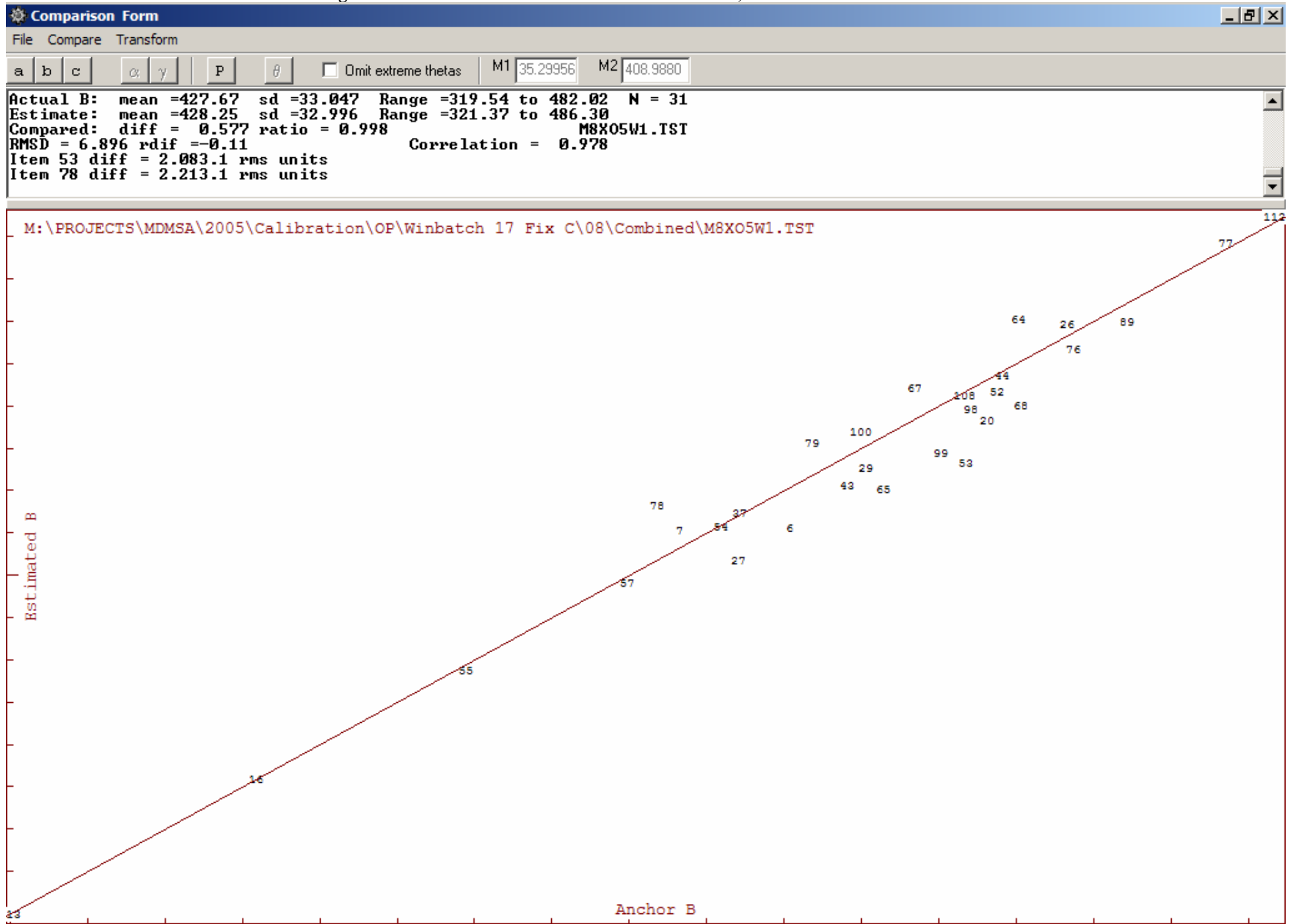


Figure 29. Estimated and Actual P Values, 2005 MSA Grade 8 Mathematics

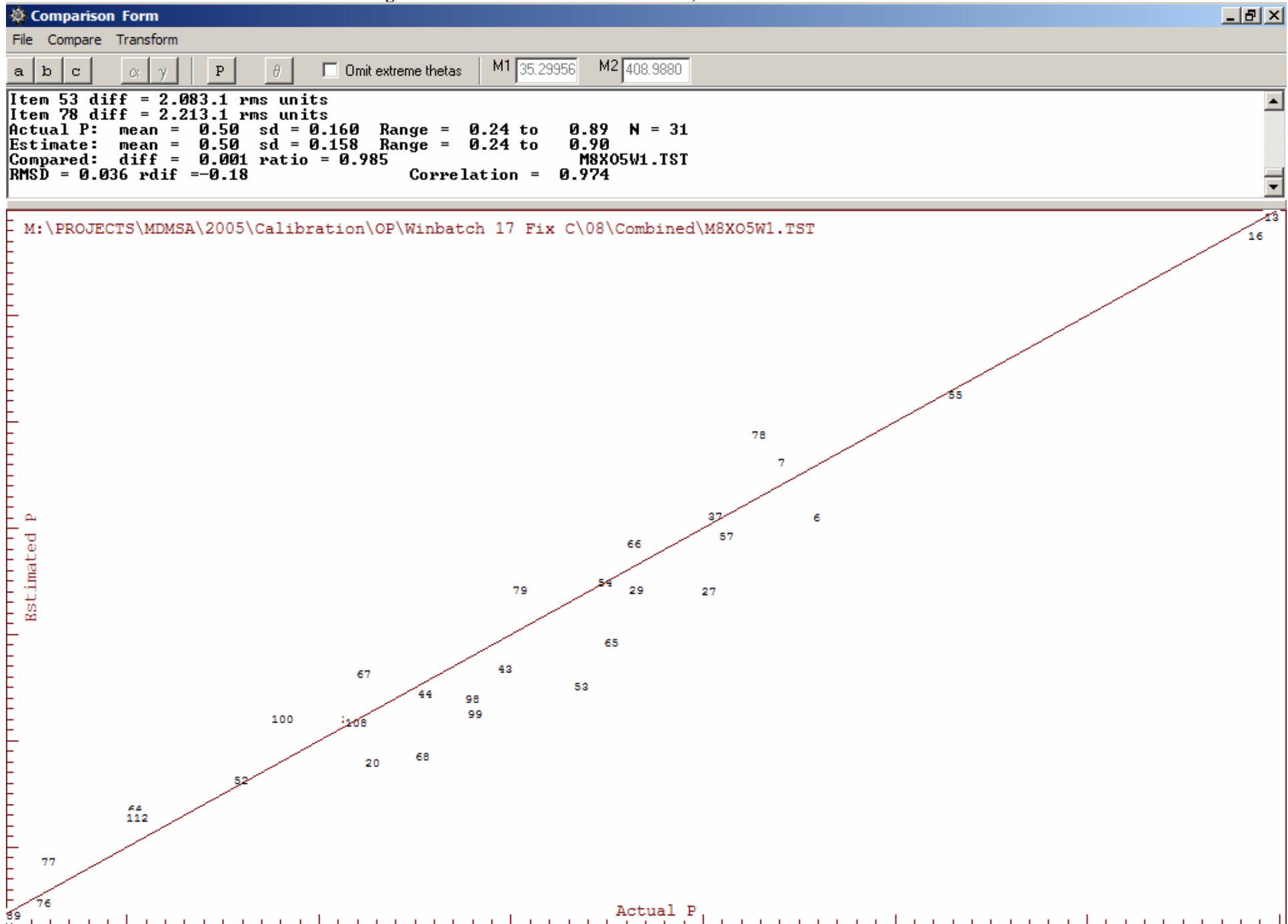


Figure 30. Stocking & Lord Test Characteristic Curves, 2005 MSA Grade 8 Mathematics

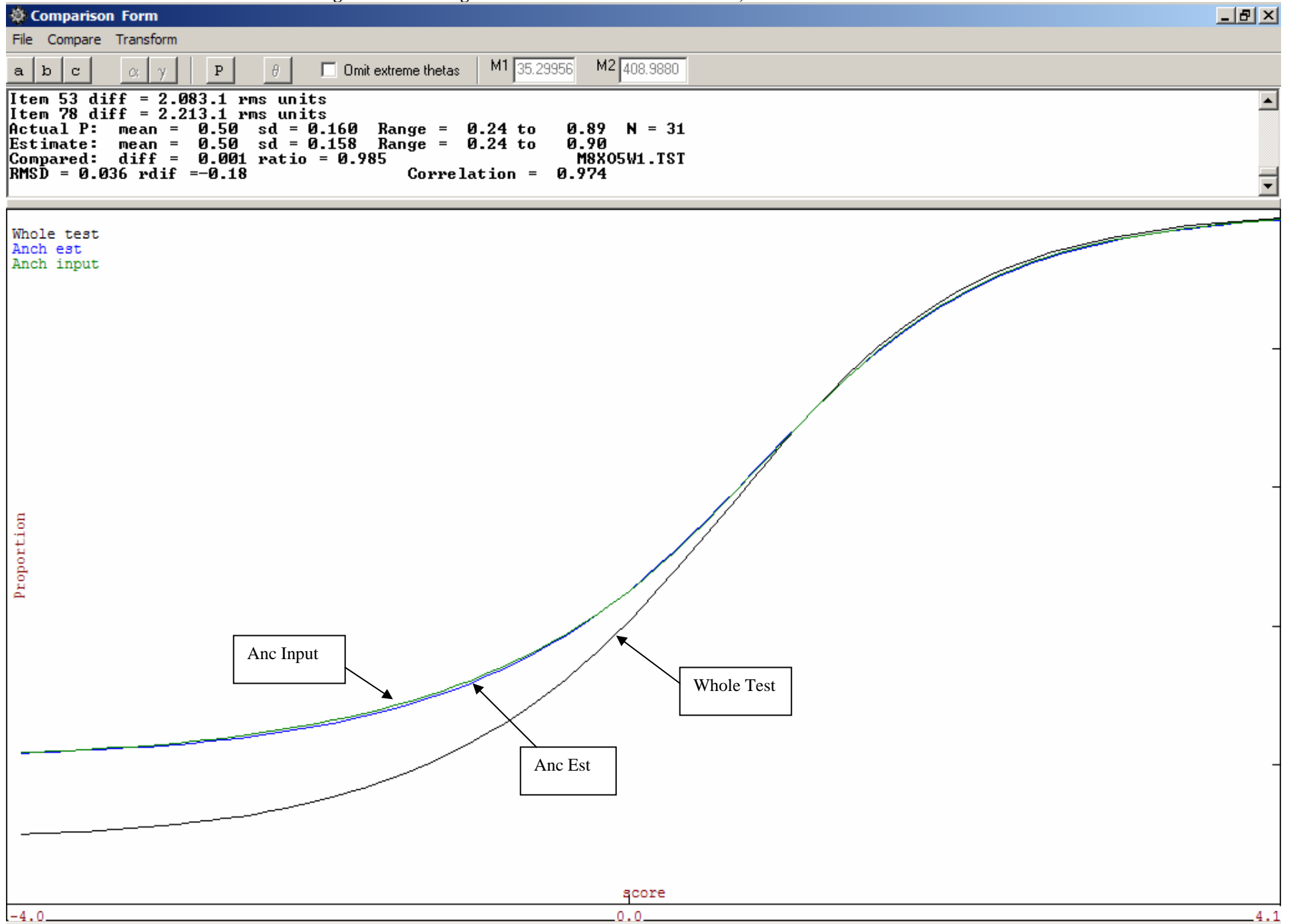


Figure 31. Grade 3 TCC & SE Plot, Form 1 and Form 2

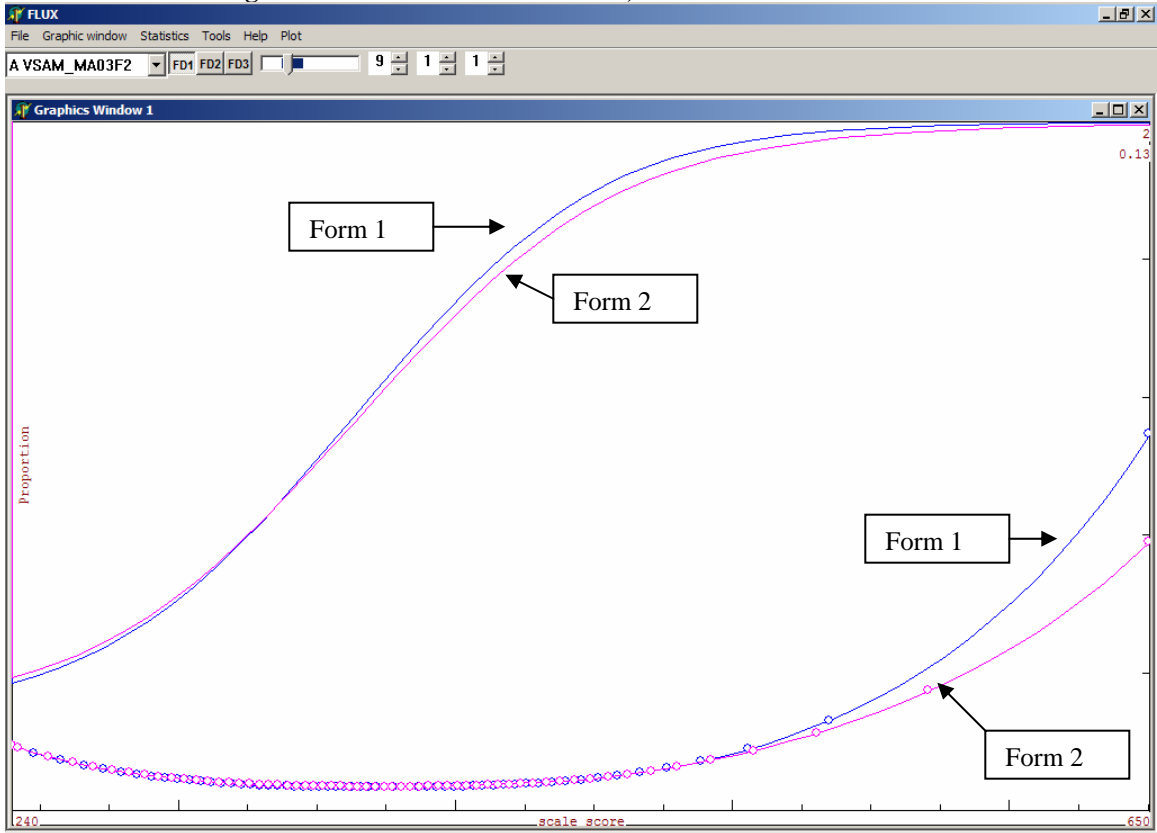


Figure 32. Grade 4 TCC & SE Plot, Form 1 and Form 2

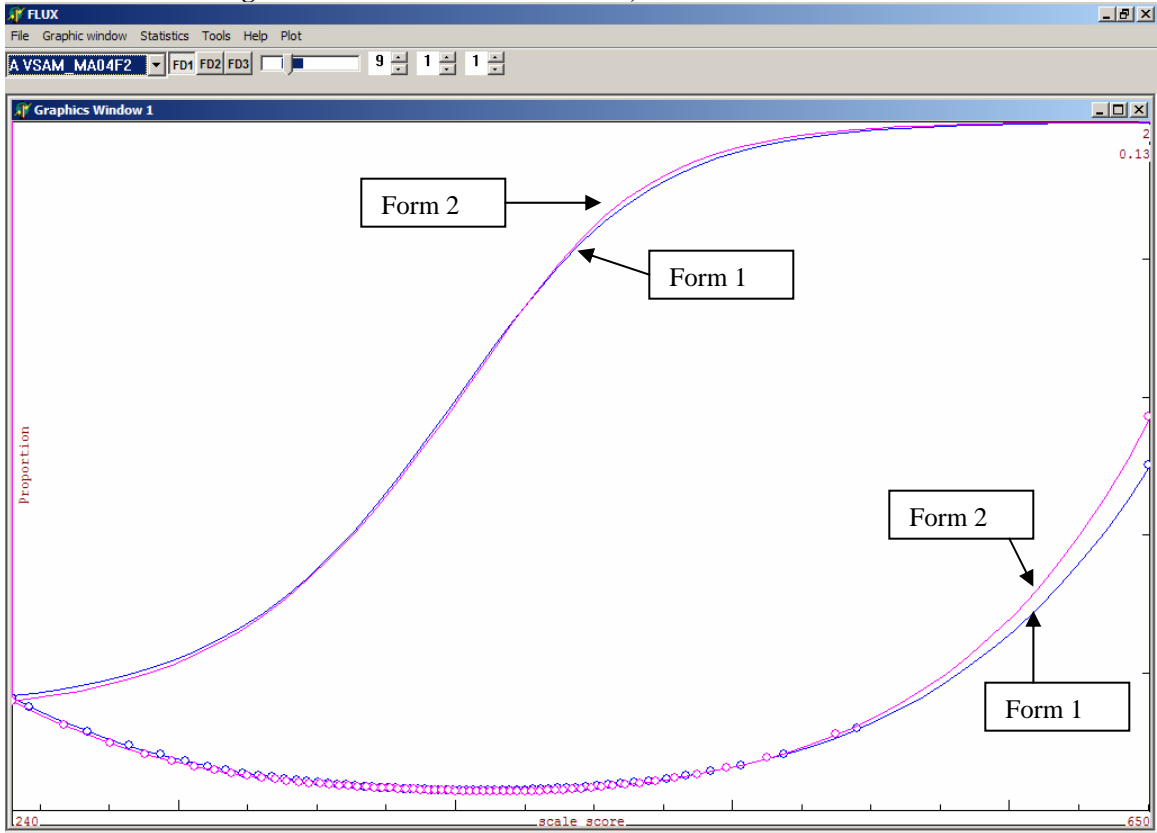


Figure 33. Grade 5 TCC & SE Plot, Form 1 and Form 2

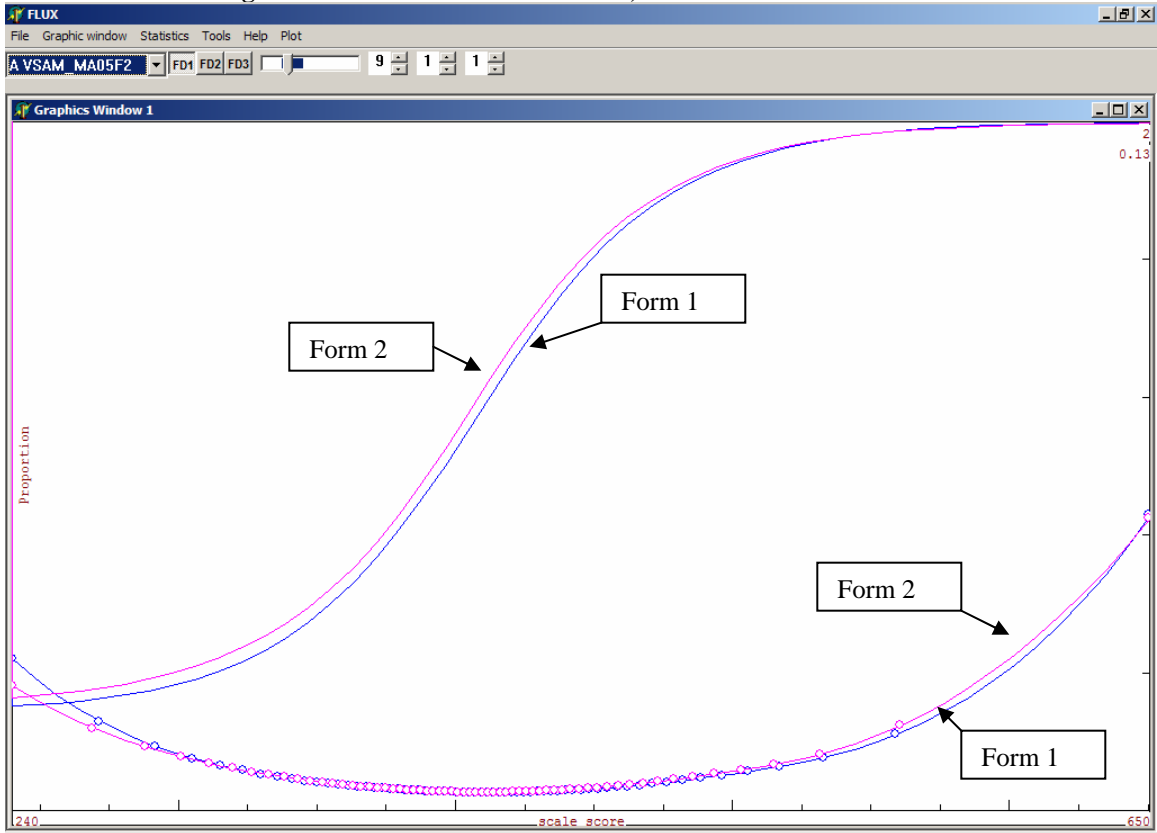


Figure 34. Grade 6 TCC & SE Plot, Form 1 and Form 2

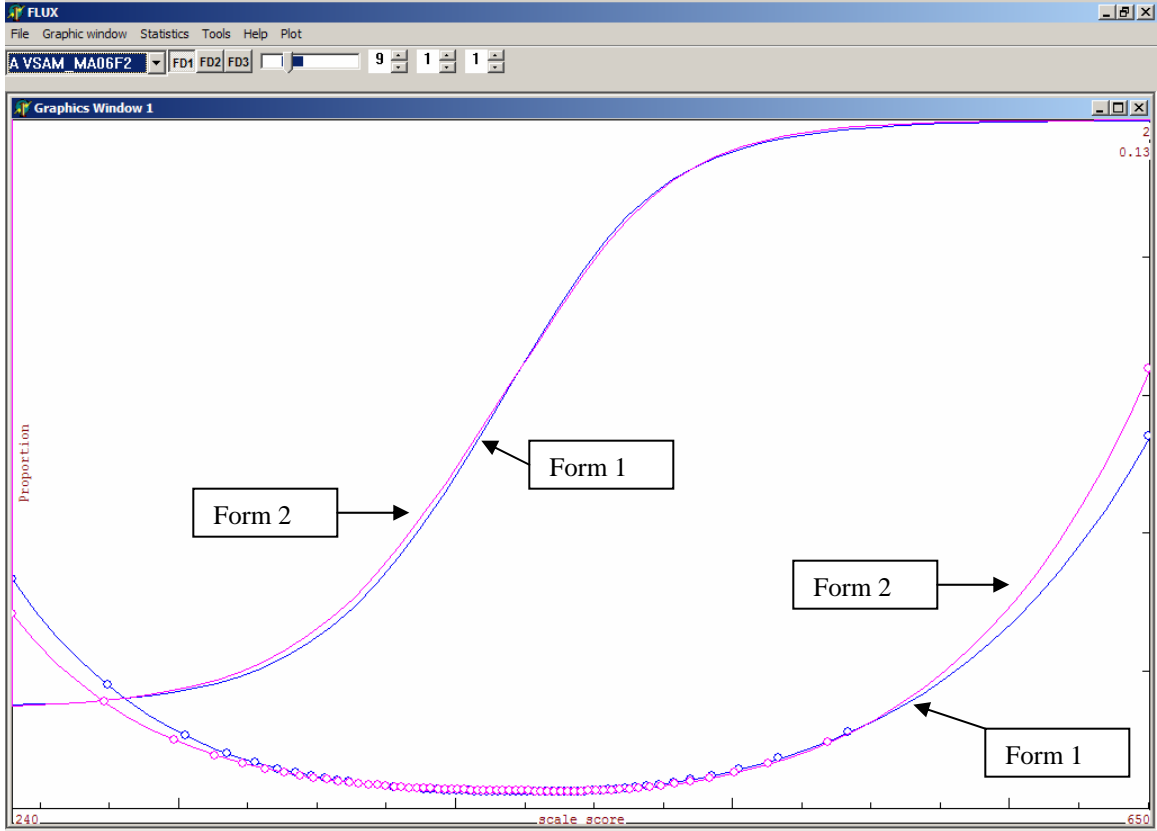


Figure 35. Grade 7 TCC & SE Plot, Form 1 and Form 2

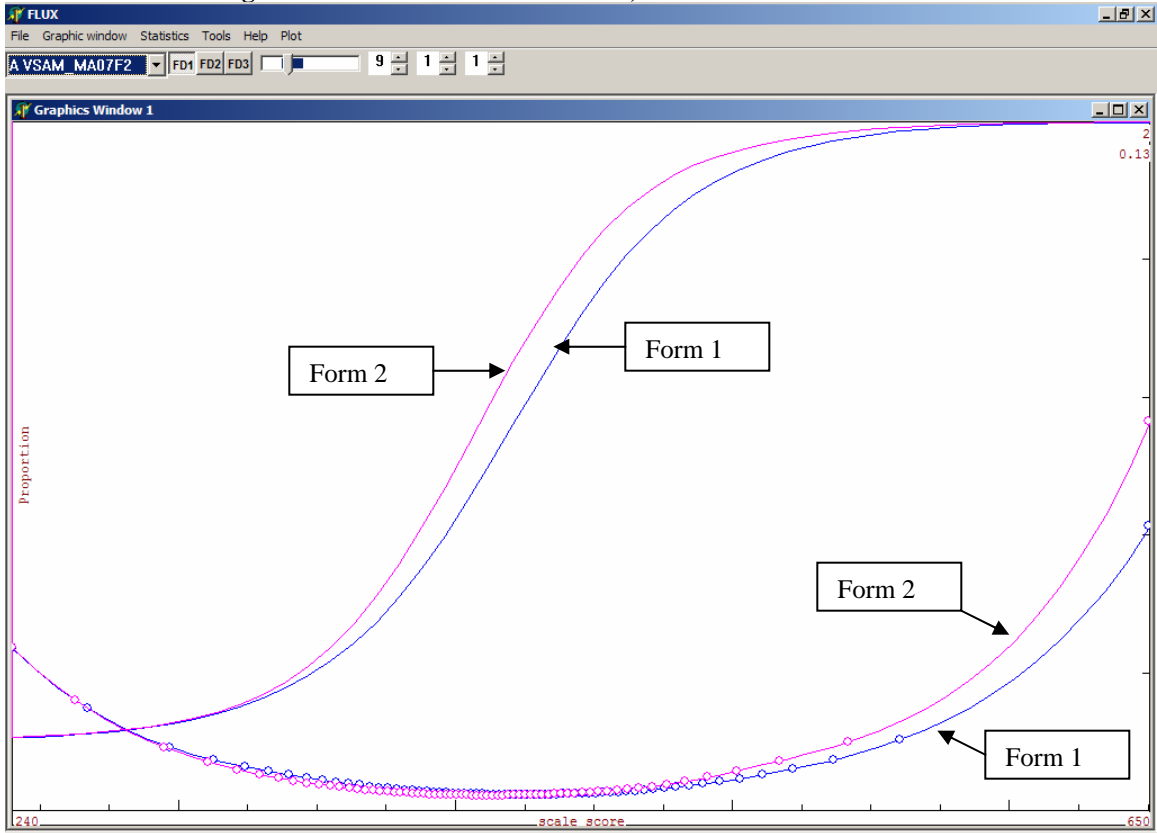


Figure 36. Grade 8 TCC & SE Plot, Form 1 and Form 2

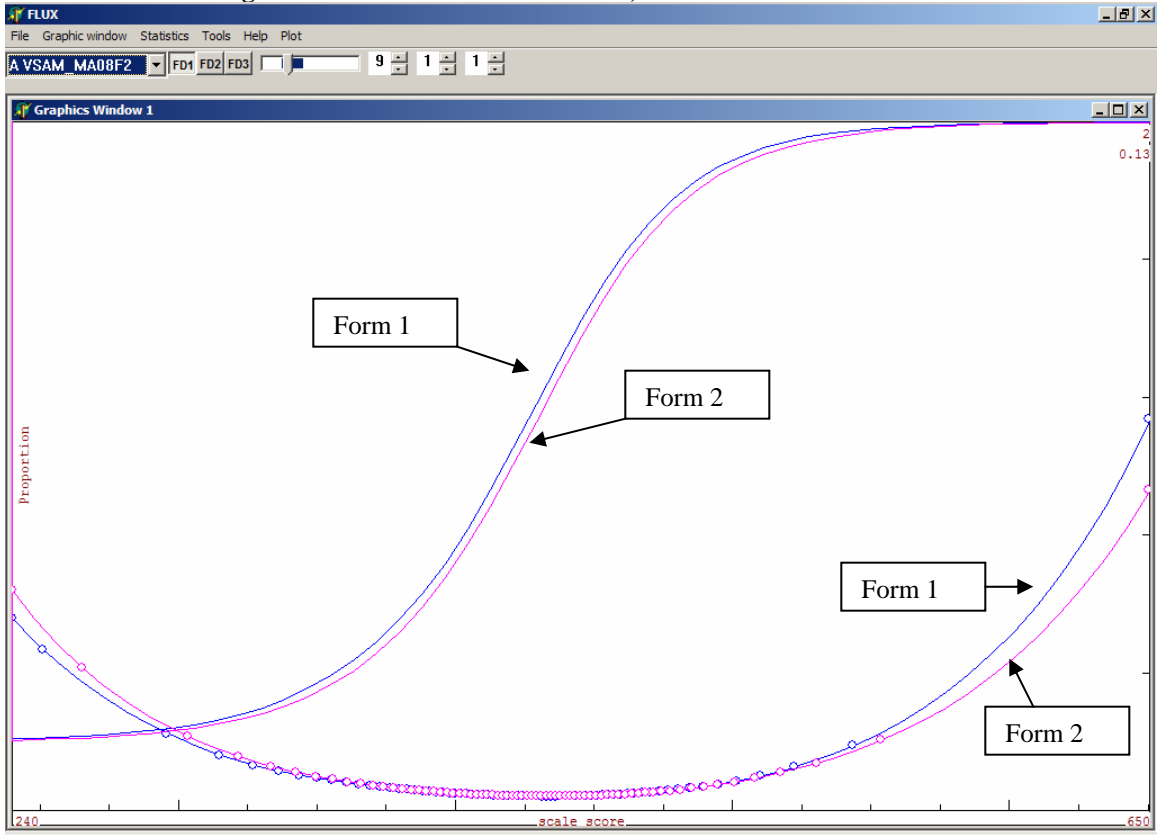

Figure 37. 2004 and 2005 Scale Score Distributions for Schools in the Grade 3 Calibration Sample

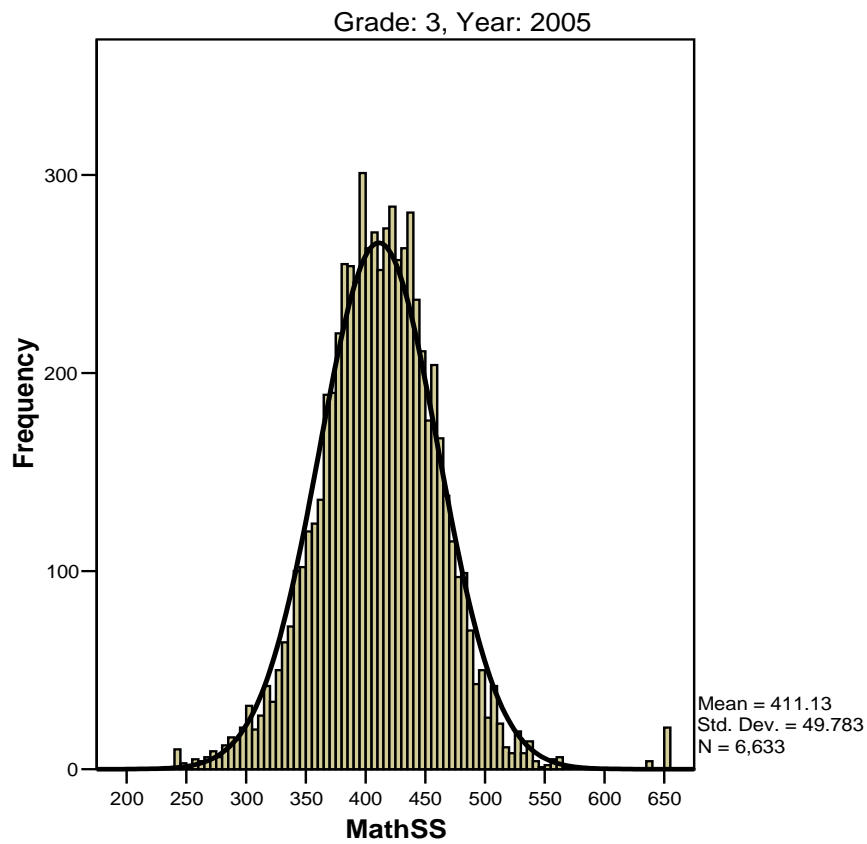
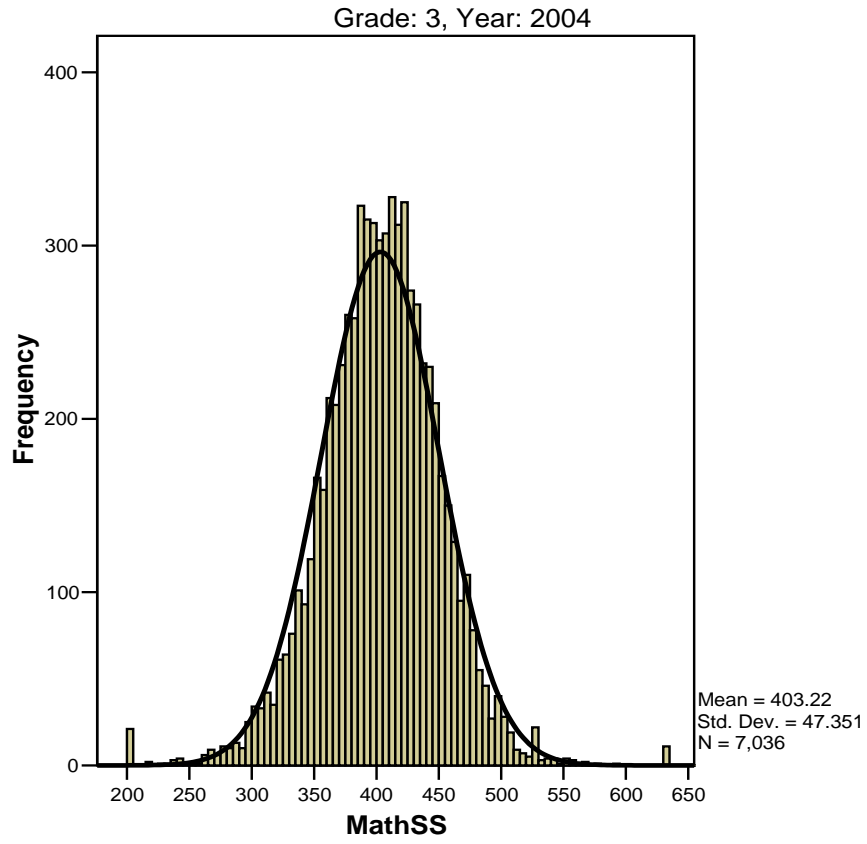


Figure 38. 2004 and 2005 Scale Score Distributions for Schools in the Grade 4 Calibration Sample

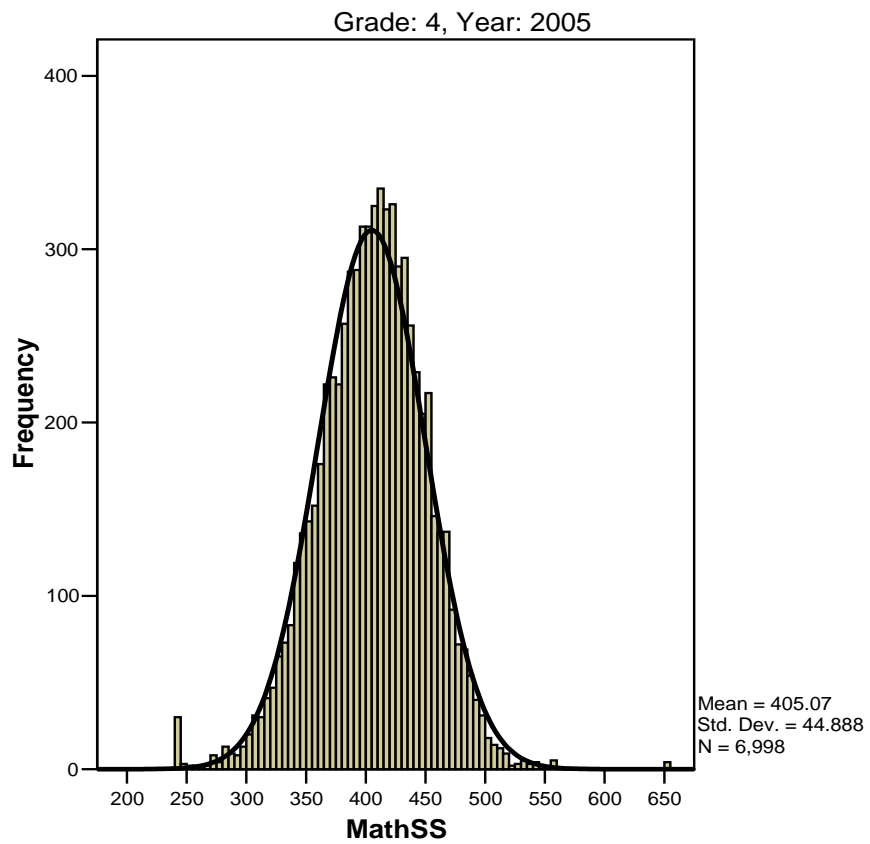
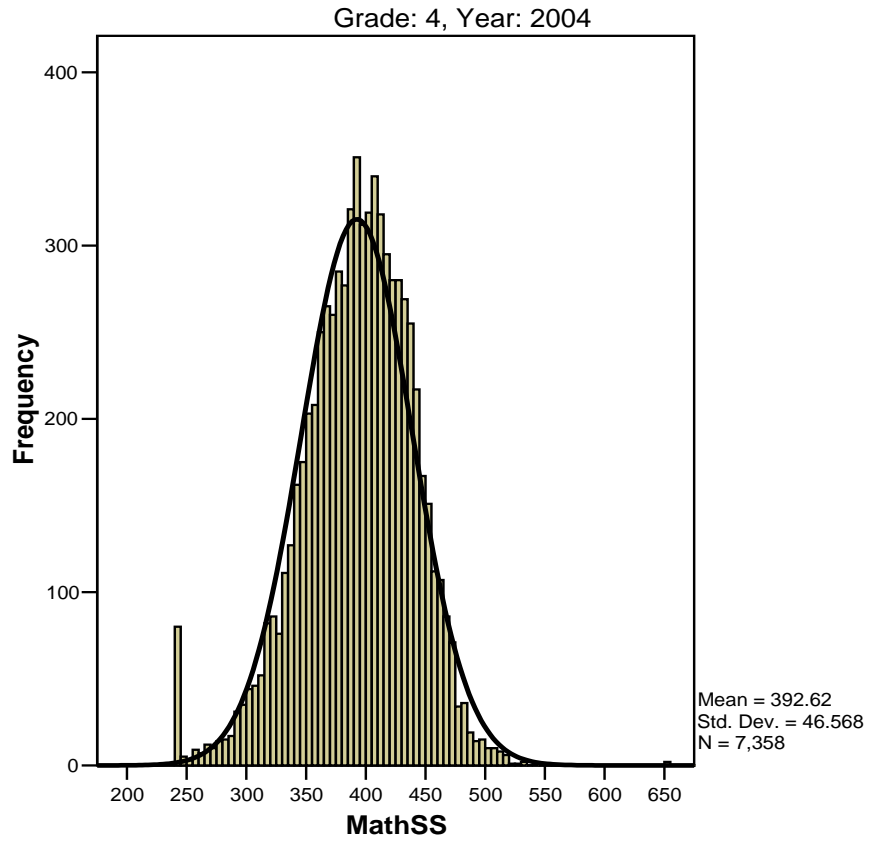


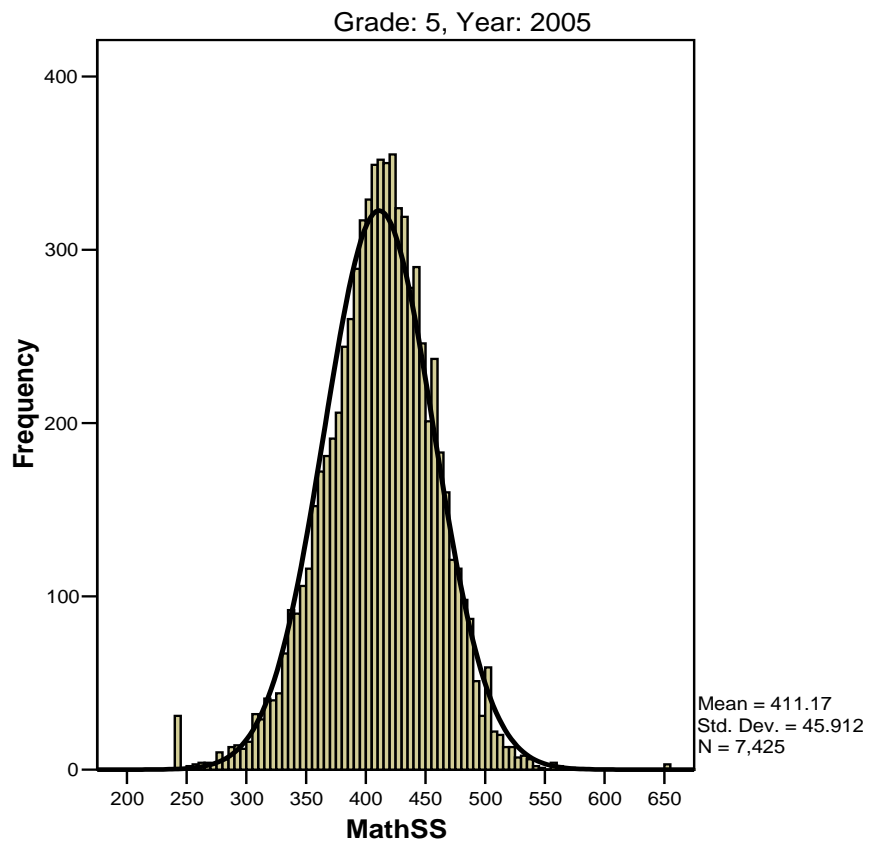
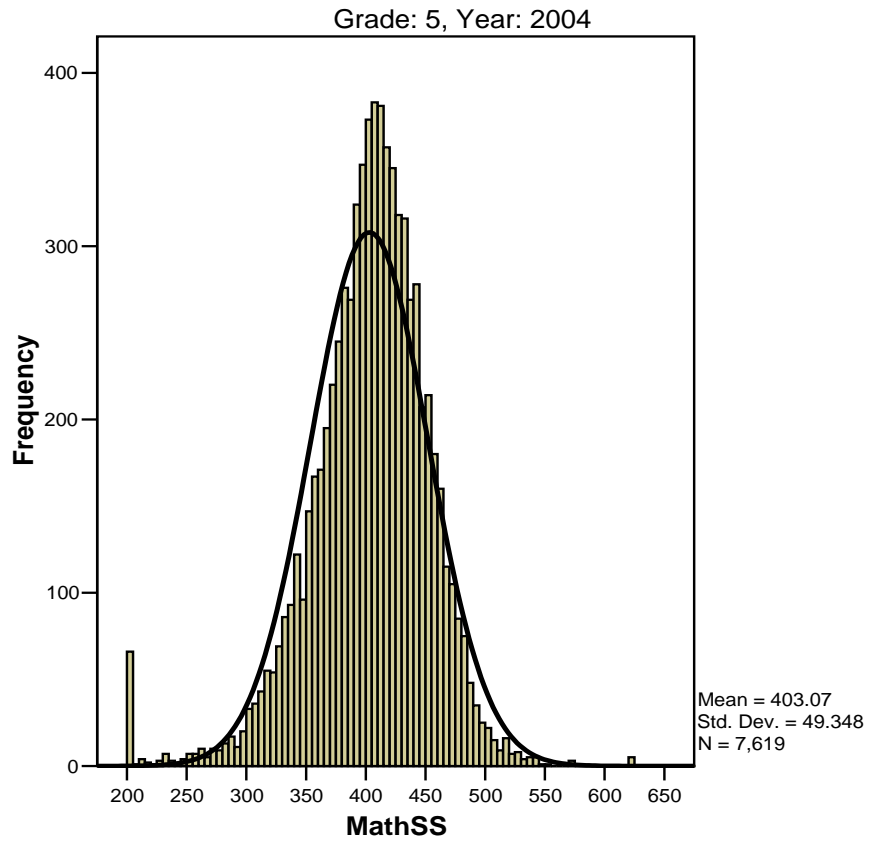
Figure 39. 2004 and 2005 Scale Score Distributions for Schools in the Grade 5 Calibration Sample

Figure 40. 2004 and 2005 Scale Score Distributions for Schools in the Grade 6 Calibration Sample

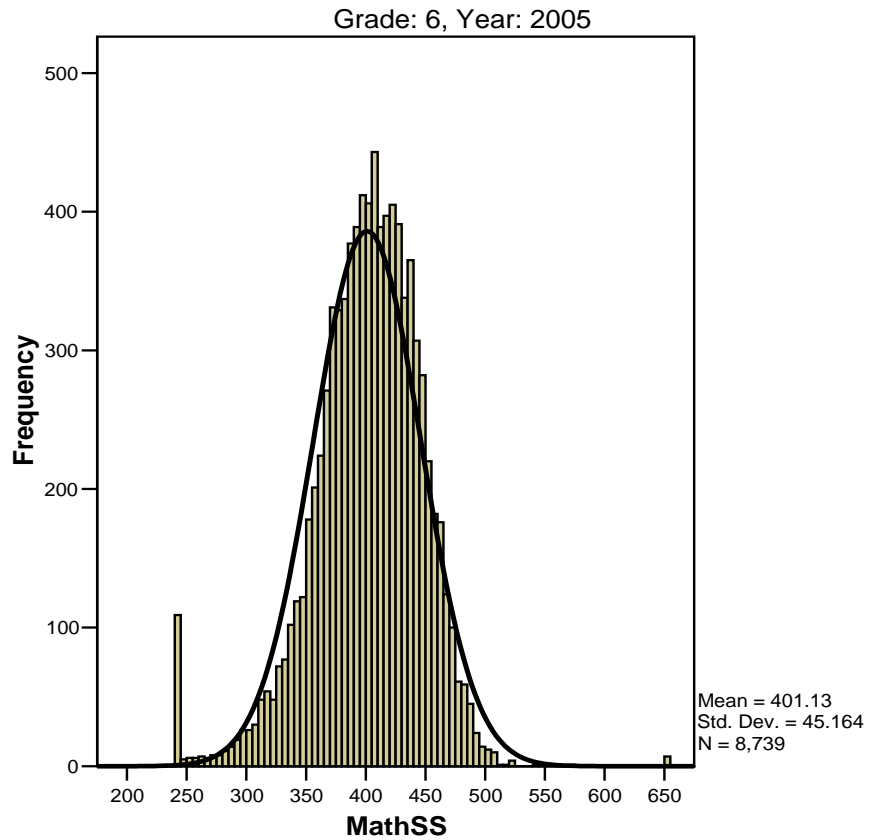
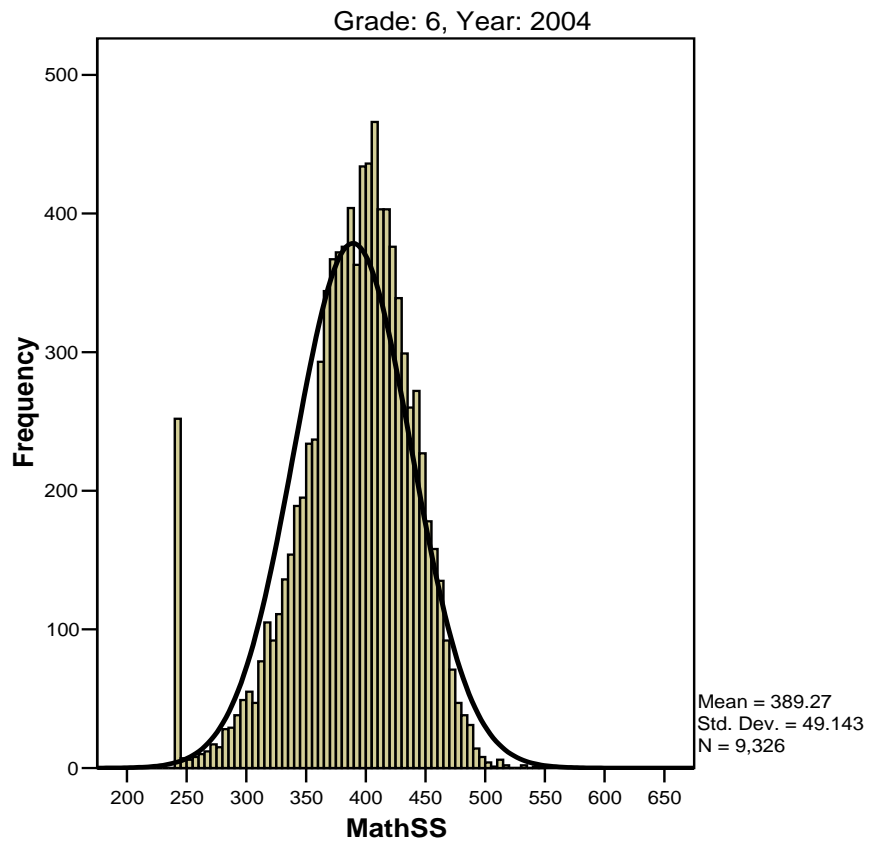


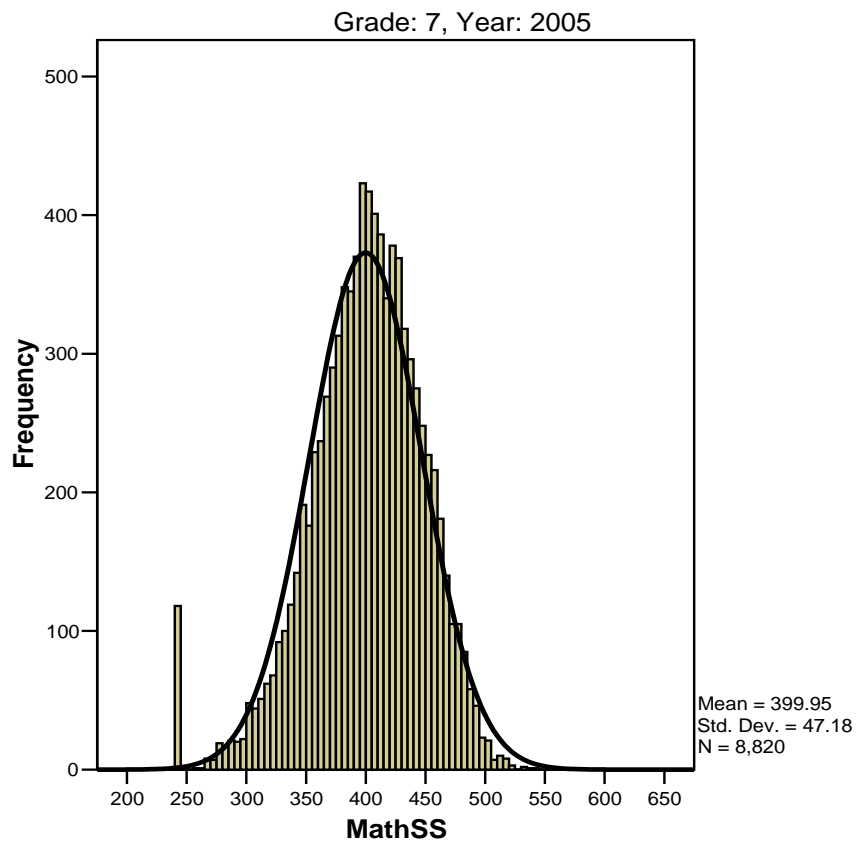
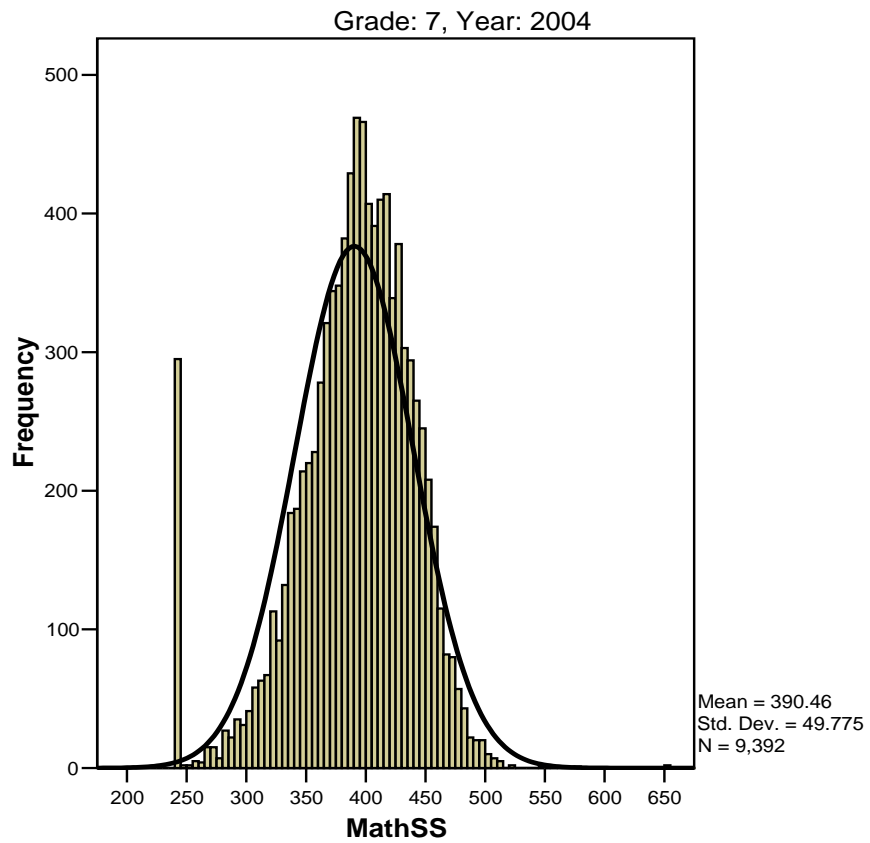
Figure 41. 2004 and 2005 Scale Score Distributions for Schools in the Grade 7 Calibration Sample

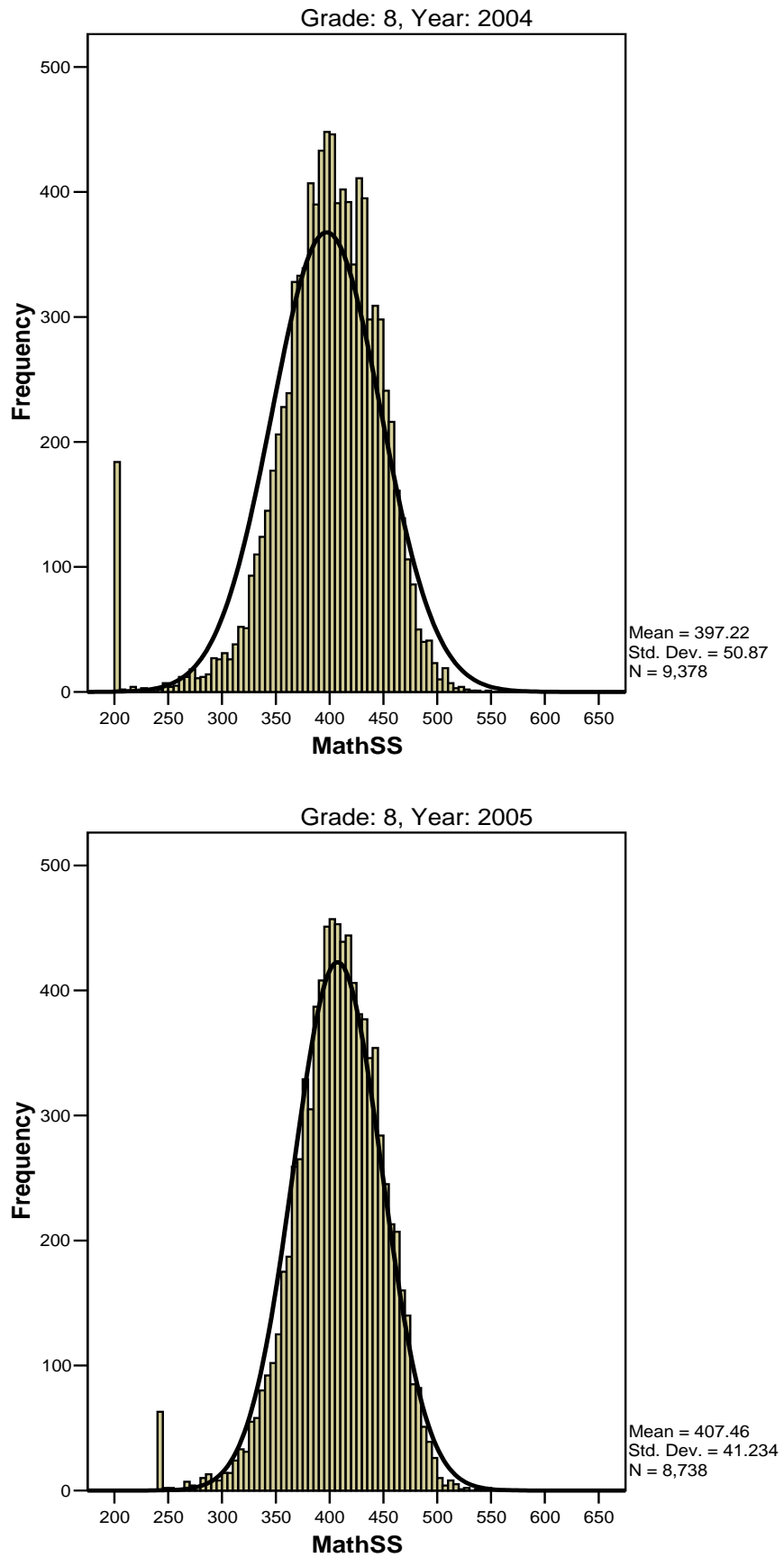
Figure 42. 2004 and 2005 Scale Score Distributions for Schools in the Grade 8 Calibration Sample
