### **ANNOUNCEMENT**

The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) in partnership with your school system invites you to consider becoming a Master Teacher for the 2011 Educator Effectiveness Academies for Reading, English Language Arts, Mathematics, or Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM). During the summer 2011, eleven Regional Educator Effectiveness Academies will be held throughout Maryland. Master teachers will be selected to facilitate the professional development for a minimum of two regional academies. These academies will include teams of teachers and principals from every school in Maryland. Academies for summer 2011 will focus on implementing the new state curriculum, the Maryland Common Core State Curriculum.

The proposed outcomes for the 2011 summer academies are as follows:

- Develop knowledge of the Maryland Common Core State Curriculum Standards and Framework.
- Develop an understanding of the relationship between Maryland's vision of STEM and the Maryland Common Core State Curriculum Framework.
- Provide feedback, modifications, and additions to curriculum work completed in 2010-2011.
- Analyze the Academy content presented to identify prerequisite skills needed and appropriate strategies for scaffolding instruction.
- Create a one-year study plan that will guide school staff in delivering the Academy content.
